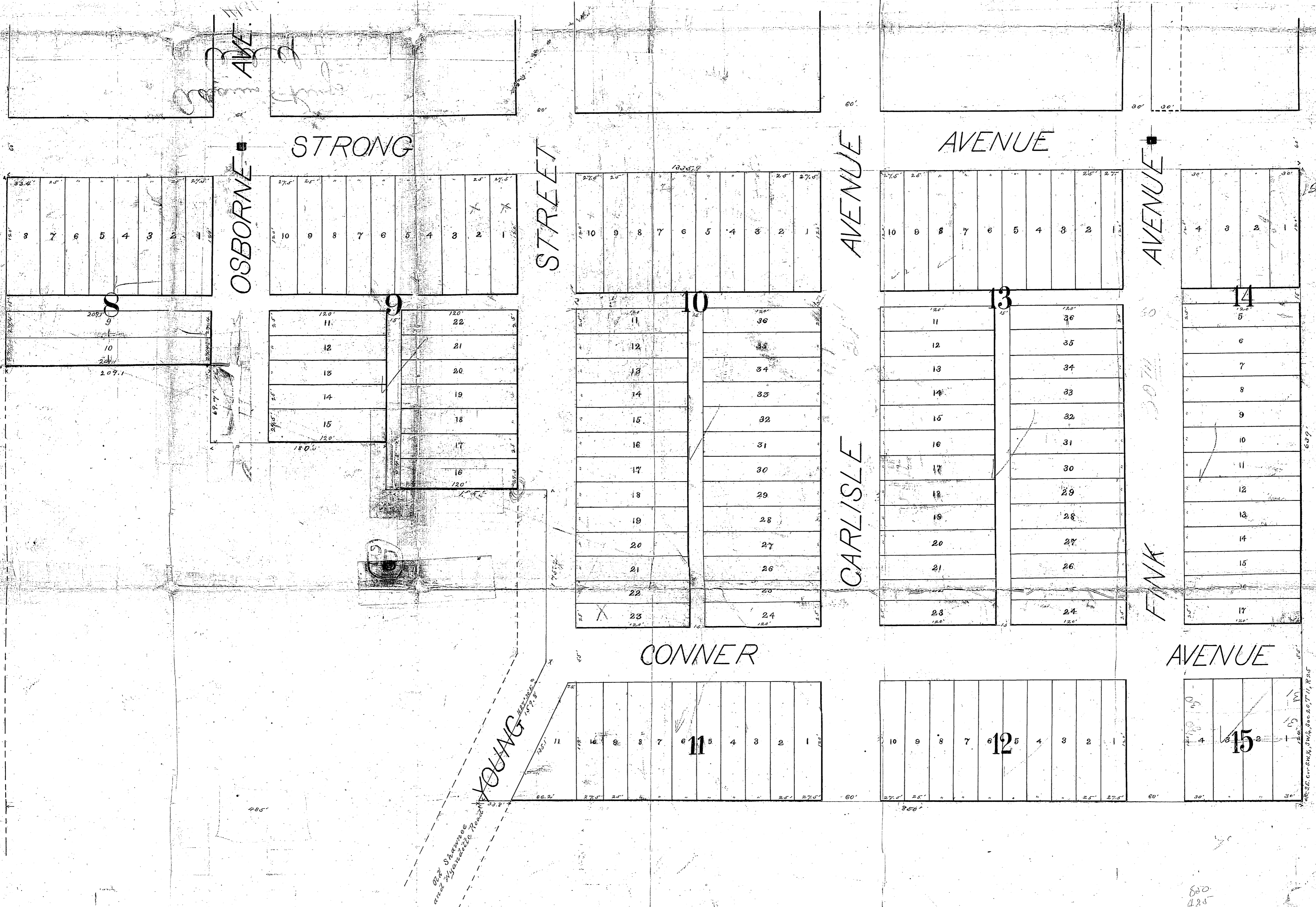


MAP

Know all men by these presents, that the undersigned owners and proprietors of the tract and parcel of land embraced in the annexed plat, situated in the County of Wyandotte, State of Kansas and described as follows to wit:

Commencing at the South East corner of the South West 1/4 of the South West 1/4 of Section 20, Town 11, Range 25, thence West 800 feet, thence North 27° 30' East 159.8 feet, thence North 175.2 feet, thence West 105 feet, thence North 54.8 feet, thence West 180 feet, thence North 69.7 feet, thence West 209.1 feet, thence North 189.8 feet, thence East 200 feet, thence South 63.9 feet to the place of commencing; do hereby lay out and plat the same into Lots, Blocks, Avenues, Streets and Alleys as shown and indicated upon said plat under the name of Adams and King's 2nd Addition to Argentine.

The parcels of ground reserved for public use as Avenues, Streets and Alleys, the names, extent and direction of all such Avenues, Streets and Alleys are designated and correctly shown upon said plat.

All lots and blocks intended for sale are set forth designated and described upon said plat by numbers, the precise length and width of each lot being thereon marked in feet and decimal parts thereof.

All Avenues, Streets and Alleys, as marked and designated thereon are hereby dedicated to the public use and purposes as such, and for no other purposes or uses.
