

This Plat of

Armourdale

covers Lands in Wyandotte County, Kansas, the boundary lines of which are described as follows:

Beginning at the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 11 S. R. 25 E.; thence southerly along the West line of E. 1/2 of said Sec. 1909 92 feet, more or less; thence easterly and parallel to the East and West center line through said Sec. 21, 1022 3/4 feet to the West line of "Armourdale", a subdivision platted April the 5th, 1887; thence northerly along the West line of said subdivision 2072 3/4 feet to the easterly prolongation of the South line of "Pacific Place"; thence Westerly along said South line and said easterly prolongation 1816 5/8 feet to the before mentioned West line of the E. 1/2 of said section; thence southerly along said West line 161 feet to the point of beginning,

containing 48 ⁴⁸³/₁₀₀₀ Acres.

The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers and letters as lots and blocks in "Armourdale". The parcels of ground reserved for public use are Avenues, Streets and Alleys.

The names, boundaries, course and extent of all such Avenues, Streets and Alleys are designated on this plat, and such Avenues, Streets and Alleys are reserved and dedicated to public purposes as such.

All lots intended for sale are set forth and described by numbers and letters in blocks. The precise length and width of each lot is set forth on this plat in small black figures. The number of each lot is shown in small red figures, and the number of each block in blue figures and letters.

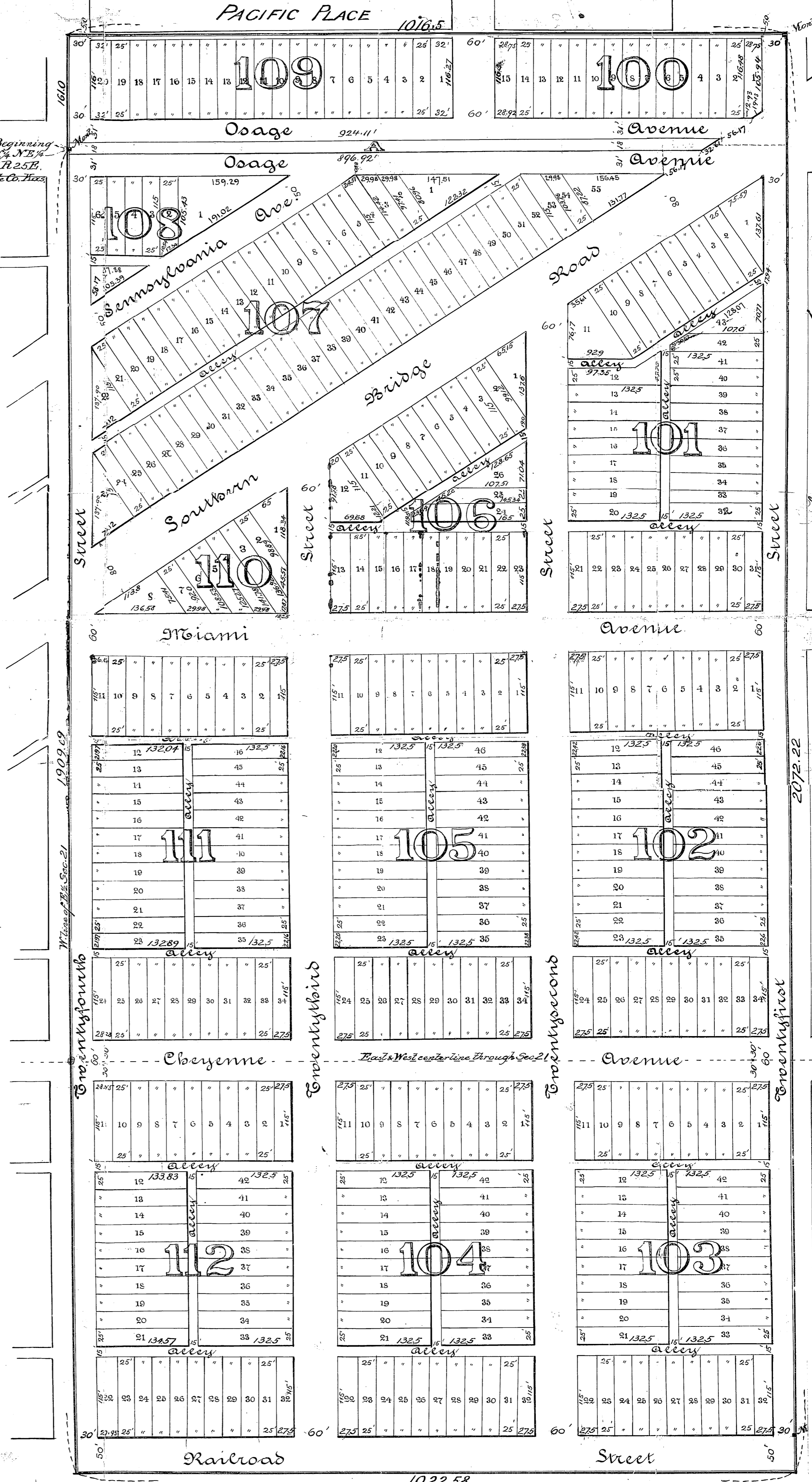
