This plat of ARMOURDALE covers land in Wyandotte County Kansas, bounded as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the South line of Kansas Avenue in Kansas City, Kansas, with the West line of Twelfth St. said point being 191ft South and 30ft West of the Northeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Sec. 21, T. 11, R 25 E Thence South 1091ft to the North line of Osage Ave. Thence West along the North line of Osage Ave 1250 ft. Thence North 1091 ft. more or less to the South line of Kansas Ave. Thence East 1250 ft to beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as blocks and lots in Armourdale, the blocks numbered with large and the lots with small figures. The parcels of ground reserved for public use are streets, avenues, and alleys. The names extent and direction of all such streets, avenues and alleys are designated on this plat and such streets, avenues and alleys are hereby dedicated to public use as such.
