Beginning at the N.W. Cor. of 12th St. and Kansas Ave in Kansas City Kansas, said point being 111 ft. south and 30 ft West of the S.E. Cor. of S.W. 1/4 of Sec 16-11-25 Thence West 695 ft.; thence North 838.6 ft. to the South line of Jameson's Add. Thence East 179 ft. to the S.E. Cor. of Jameson's Add. Thence North along the East line of Jameson's Add. 76 ft. to the center of Berger Ave. Thence East 515.9 ft. to the West line of 12th St Thence South to beginning

The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as blocks and lots in ARMOURDALE, the blocks being numbered with large blue figures and the lots with small black figures. The parcels of ground reserved for public use are streets, avenues and alleys. 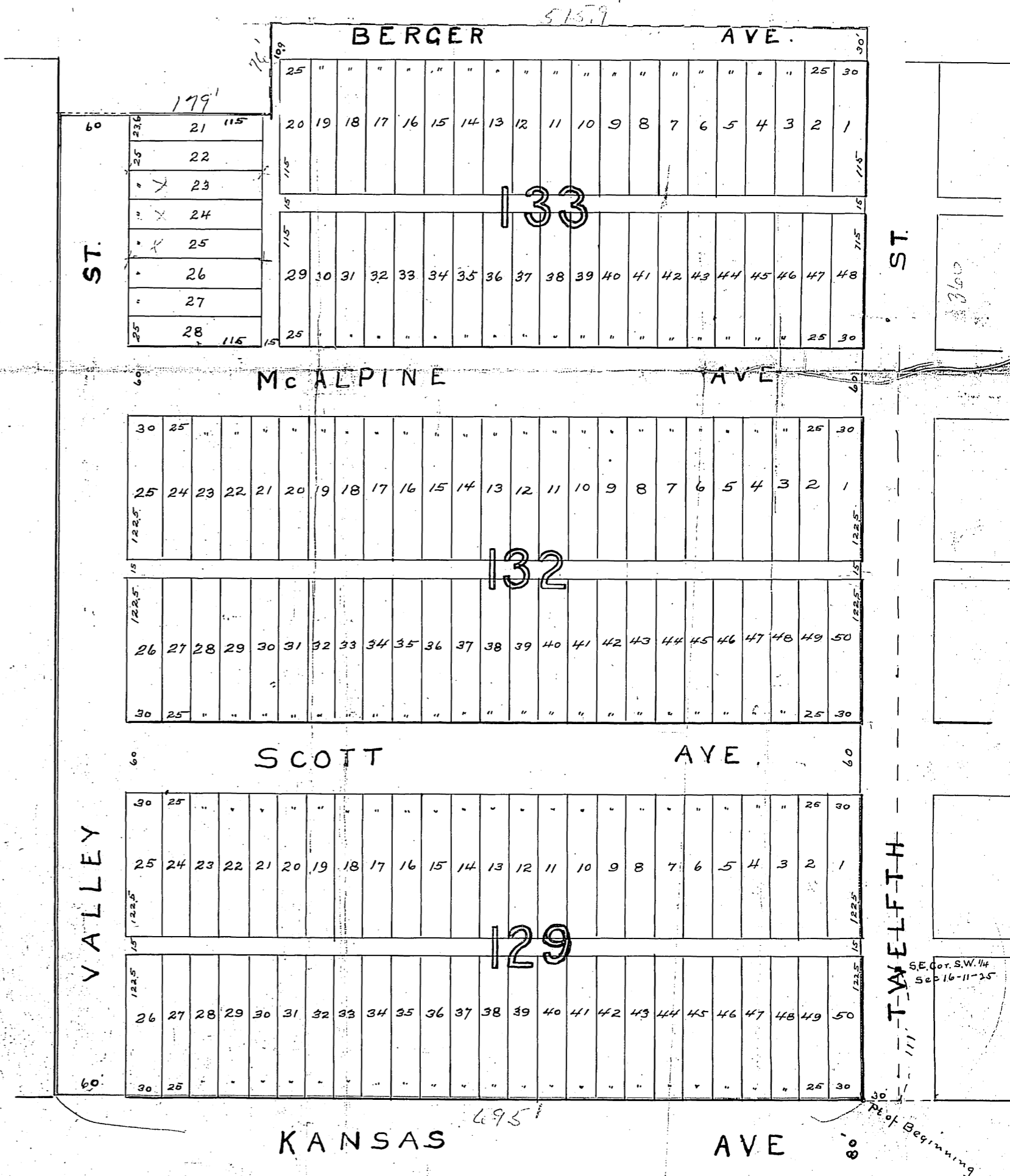
