This Plat of Armourdale covers land in Wyandotte County Kansas thus described to wit:—

Beginning at the north west corner of Kansas Avenue and Valley Street in Kansas City, Kansas, said point being seven hundred twenty four and six tenths (724.6) feet, more or less, west and one hundred and eleven (111) feet south of the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of section 21, Township 11 South, Range 25 East; thence north along the west line of Valley Street, eight hundred thirty eight and six (838.6) feet, more or less, to the south line of Jameson's Addition; thence west along the said south line five hundred ninety-five (595) feet, more or less, to the west line of the south east quarter of the south west quarter of Sec. 16-T11-R25; thence north along said west line and the west line of the north east quarter of the north west quarter of Sec 21-T11-R25, eight hundred thirty eight and twelve hundredths (838.12) feet, more or less, to the north line of said Kansas Avenue; thence east along said north line five hundred ninety-five and seventy-four hundredths (595.74) feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers, as blocks and lots in "Armourdale", the blocks being numbered with large and the lots with small figures.

The parcels of ground in this subdivision reserved for public use are streets, avenues and alleys. The names, extent and direction of such streets, avenues and alleys are designated on this plat and they are hereby dedicated to public use as such.
