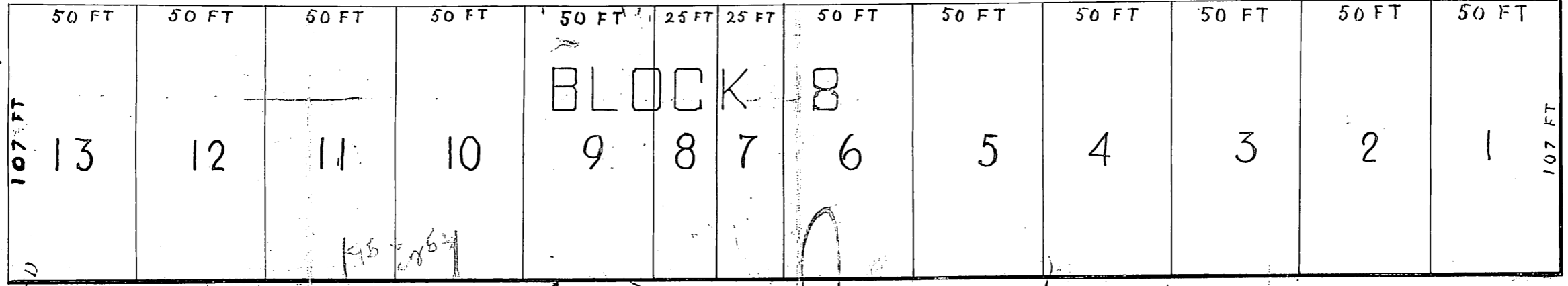


BARNES Addition to WESTERN HIGH LANDS

This flat subdivision is the land covered and included by the blocks numbered eight (8) and nine (9), the alleys therein and Short Street of the flat and subdivision of land dedicated and filed by John Long and wife under the name of Barnes Addition to Western Highlands, which contained twenty-five and 7/8 acres (more or less) of land situate in Wyandotte County, in the State of Kansas; and was bounded and described as follows, to wit: Commencing Fifty-three (53) poles south of the center of section No. Thirty-two (32) Townshipto. Ten (10) in Range No. Twenty-five; thence, East Eighty-one (81) poles, South One (1) pole;



thence, West One (1) pole; thence, South Fifty (50) poles; thence, West Eighty (80) poles; thence, North Fifty (50) poles, to the place of beginning, and which said blocks No. Eight and nine, the alleys therein, and Short Street, was vacated by the order of the Board of County Commissioners of said County, entered upon page Seventy-three (73) of Journal B of their proceedings.

The parcels of said lands reserved for sale, by this plat, are described by numbers as Block - and Lots - - in Barnes Addition to Western Highlands; the Block being numbered and designated by a large black figure, and the Lots by small black figures.

As to part of said lands are reserved for public use. All said lots are reserved and intended for sale, and are set forth and described by numbers in the Block and the precise length and width of each lot, in feet, is set forth in this plat, in small red figures.
