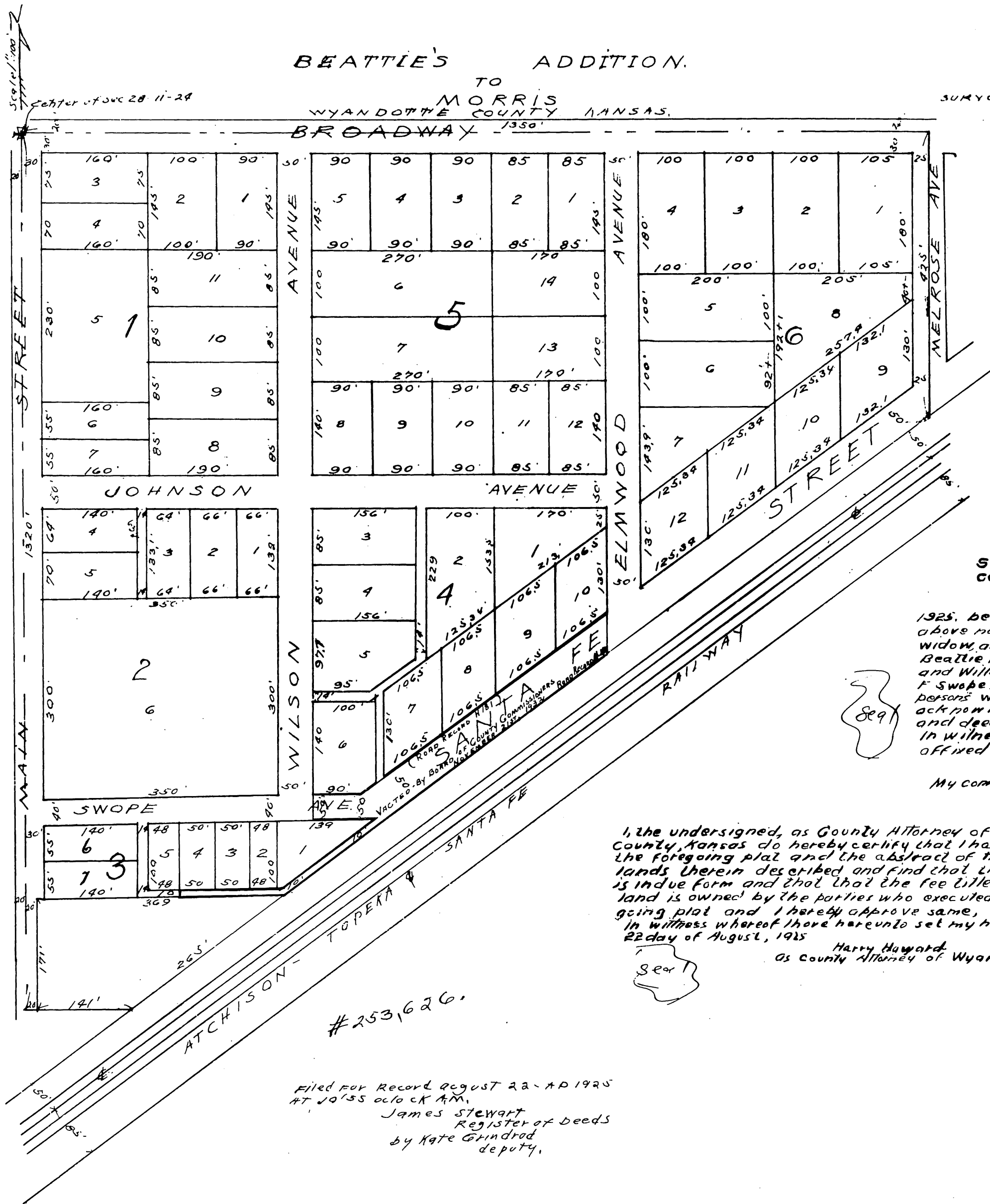


BEATTIE'S ADDITION.

DESCRIPTION
This plat of Beattie's Addition to Morris contains land in Wyandotte County, Kansas described as follows:

All of the North West 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec 28-11-24 lying north of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway, except the following described tract, commencing at the S.W. Cor of NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec 28-11-24, thence North 171 ft, thence east 369 ft to RA thence S. 55 1/4 W. 265 ft to a point 141 ft East of beginning, thence West to beginning.

DEDICATION
The lands intended for sale are designated by numbers as lots in Beattie's Addition to Morris, the dimensions of which are shown on this plat.
