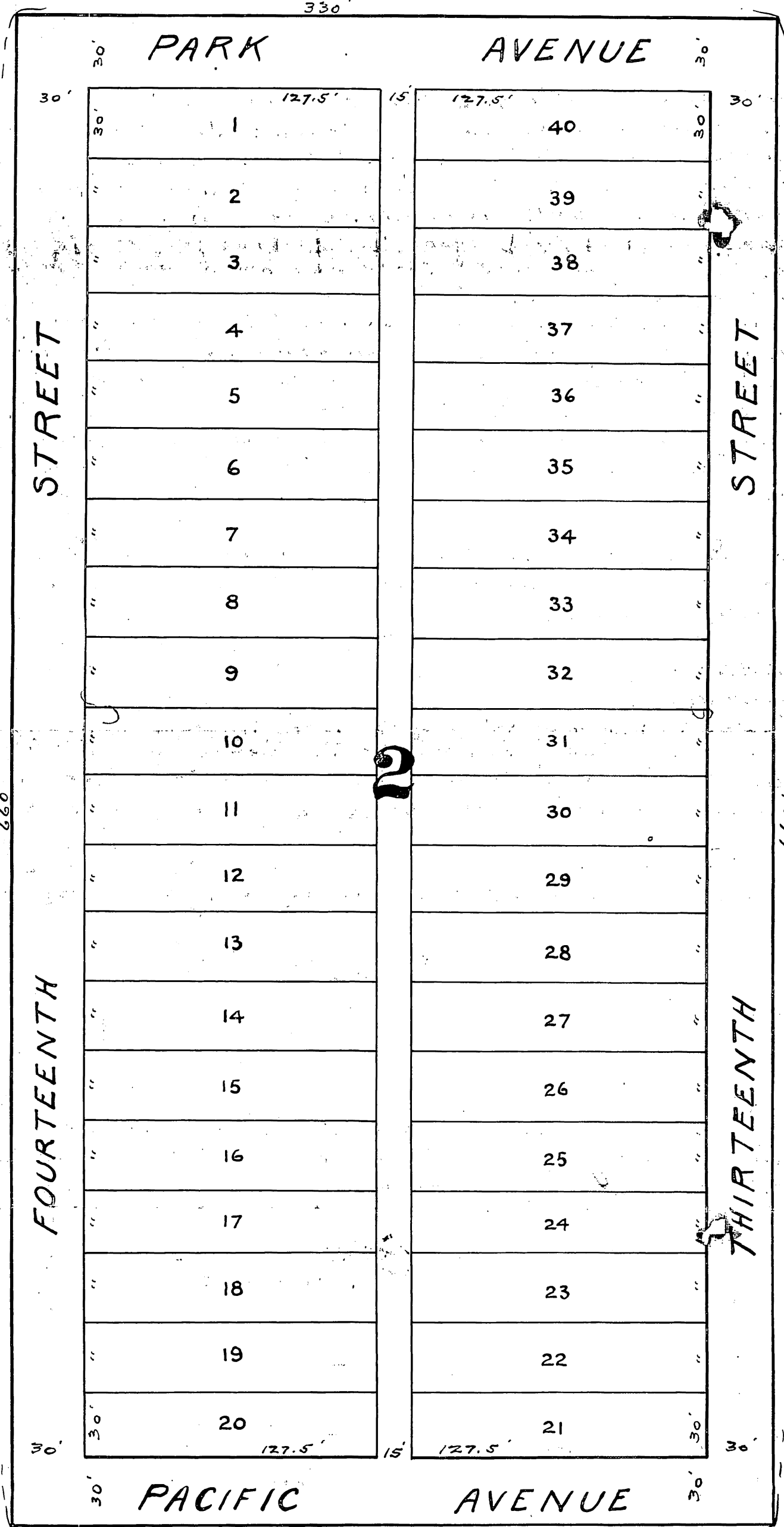


BOSTON PLACE ANNEX BLOCK 2



This Plat of BOSTON PLACE ANNEX covers land in Wyandotte County Kansas, described as follows, to wit:—
 Beginning at the south east corner of the north west quarter of the north west quarter of Section sixteen (16) - Township eleven (11) - Range twenty-five (25); thence north six hundred and sixty (660) feet; thence east three hundred and thirty (330) feet; thence south six hundred and sixty (660) feet; thence west three hundred and thirty (330) feet to the point of beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are designated by numbers from 1 to 40 inclusive, the exact size and dimensions of which are indicated on this plat in small figures and they will hereafter be known as lots in Block 2 of Boston Place Annex.

The parcels of ground intended for public use are streets, avenues and alleys, the name extent and direction of which are shown and they are hereby dedicated to public use as such.
