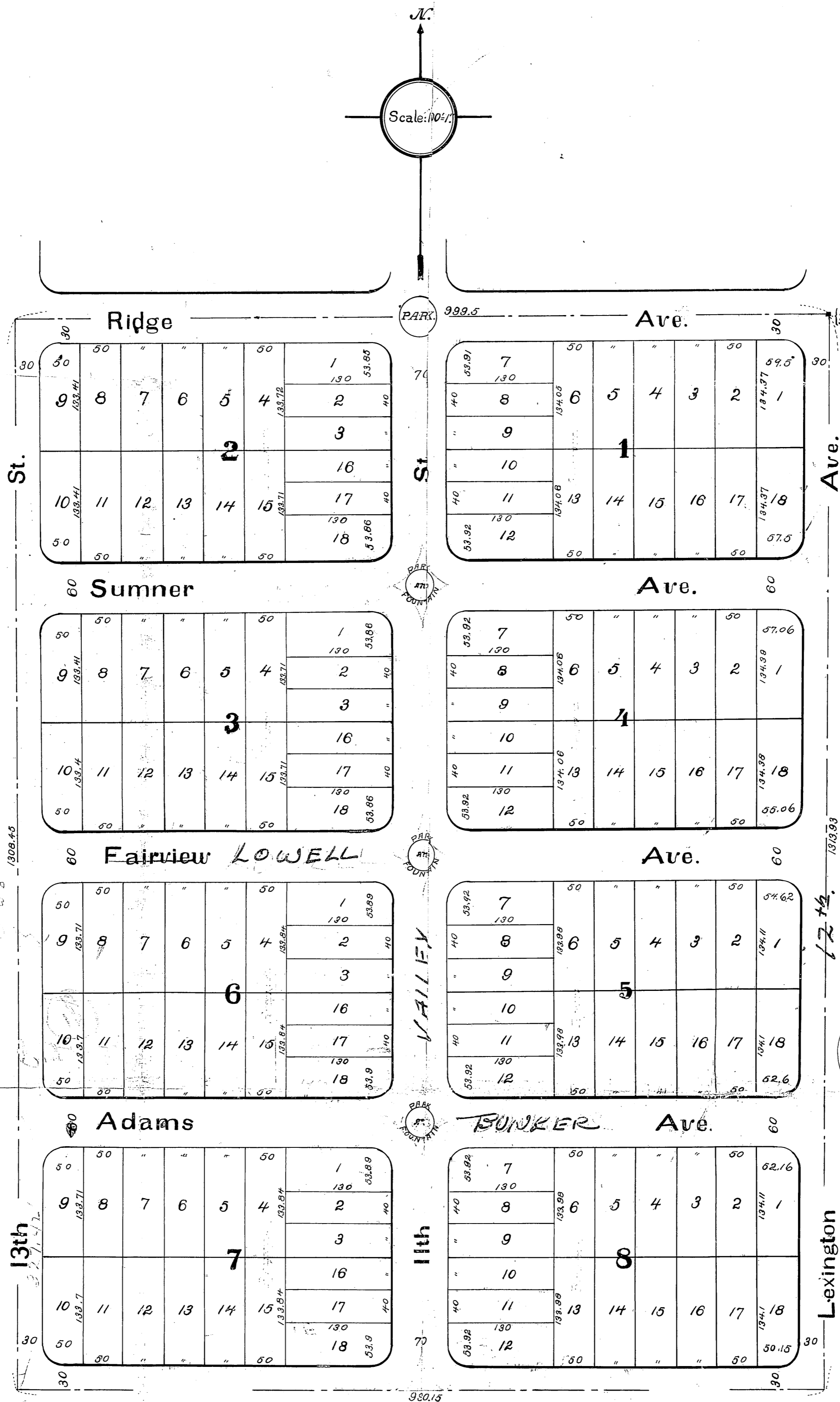


BOSTON PLACE.

THIS PLAT of BOSTON PLACE covers land in Wyandotte County, Kansas, thus described; to wit:— Beginning at the North-east corner of the North-east one-fourth (1/4) of the North-west one-fourth (1/4) of Section sixteen (16), Township eleven (11), Range twenty-five (25), East, and running thence South, along the East line of the North-west 1/4 of said Section 16, One Thousand Three Hundred Thirteen and Ninety-three hundredths (1313.93) feet, to a stone; thence West Nine Hundred Ninety and Fifteen hundredths (990.15) feet, to a stake; thence North and parallel with the West line of the North-east 1/4 of the North-west 1/4 aforesaid, One Thousand Three Hundred Eight and Forty-five hundredths (1308.45) feet, to a stake in the North line of said Section 16; thence East Nine Hundred Ninety-nine and Five tenths (999.5) feet, to the place of beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are described, by numbers, as blocks and lots in Boston Place; the blocks being numbered with large, and the lots with small figures. The parcels of ground in this subdivision reserved for public use are streets and avenues. The names, extent and direction of all such streets and avenues, are designated on this plat; and such streets and avenues are hereby dedicated to public use, as such.

In testimony whereof the Boston Land and Park Company, proprietors of said BOSTON PLACE causes this plat to be signed by its President and Secretary; and its common and corporate seal to be hereunto affixed, this 4th day of November, 1887.
