

BOULEVARD HEIGHTS.

AN ADDITION TO KANSAS CITY, KANSAS.

Description

beginning at a point 213.10 ft. North of the S.E. cor. of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 32, T. 10, R. 25 E. in the Co. of Shaw, where said line intersects the North line of Duwanda Boulevard, thence S. 73° 35' E. 115 ft. with the North line of said Boulevard to a point, said point being 288.70 ft. East of line of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 32 aforesaid; thence North and parallel with the East line of the aforesaid 559.70 ft. to a point; thence West and parallel with the South line of the aforesaid, 288.70 ft. to a point; thence North with the East line of the N.E. 1/4 aforesaid 929.70 ft.; thence West and parallel with the South line of the N.E. 1/4 aforesaid, 629 ft. to a point; thence South and parallel with the East line of the N.E. 1/4 aforesaid 1219.80 ft. to the North line of Duwanda Boulevard, thence S. 73° 35' E. 655.25 ft. to beginning.

The undersigned proprietors of the above described tract of land, have caused the same to be subdivided in the manner as shown on the above plat and said subdivision shall hereafter be known as "Boulevard Heights".
