

BROWNE'S PARK.

Browne's Park covers land in Wyandotte County Kansas thus bounded to wit:

Commencing at a point in the center of the Quindaro Road six hundred and twenty seven (627) feet west from the East line of section thirty two (32) Town ten (10) South, Range twenty five East of the sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, thence South two hundred and sixty three (263) feet, thence West six hundred and ninety three (693) feet, thence North eighty four degrees and thirty minutes (84° 30') West sixteen hundred and ninety (1690) feet to center of County Road, thence North eight hundred and thirty and one half (830 1/2) feet to center of Quindaro Road, thence South easterly along said road to place of beginning.
