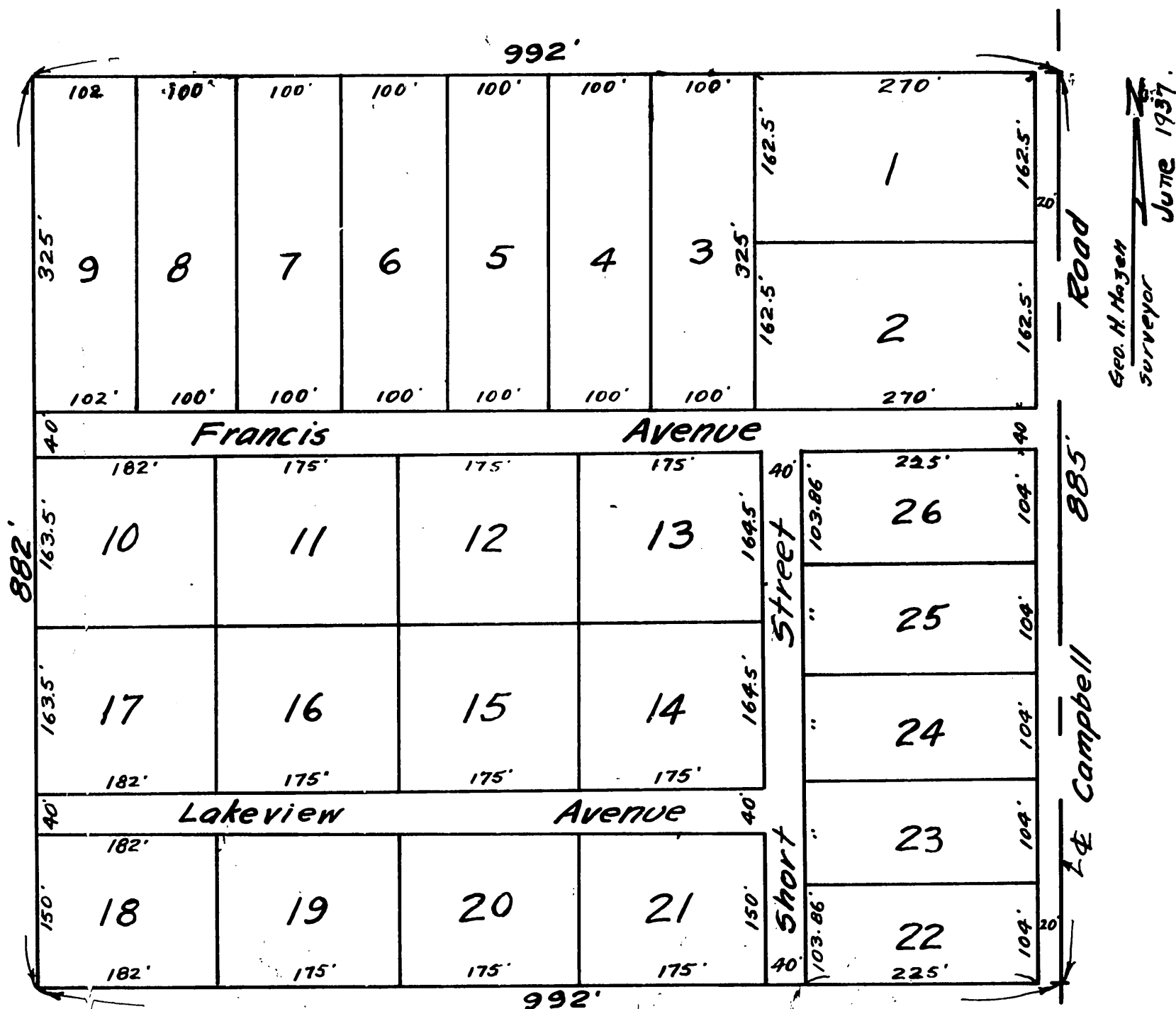

# CAMPBELLS CABINSITES

This Plat of "Campbell's Cabinsites" covers land in Wyandotte County, Kansas, described as follows; beginning at a point fifty three and one third poles North of the Southeast corner of the Northwest one-quarter of Section Thirty in Township Ten South in Range Twenty-Four East. Thence West Sixty Poles, thence North Fifty Three and one third Poles, thence East Sixty Poles, thence South Fifty Three and one third Poles to the place of beginning.

The Undersigned owners of the above described land have caused the same to be subdivided into Twenty Six parcels, the exact size of each being shown hereon, and they shall hereafter be known as "Campbell's Cabinsites". They are reserved for sale.

The parcels of Land intended for public use are Three Roads Forty feet wide and they are hereby dedicated to the public for travel.
