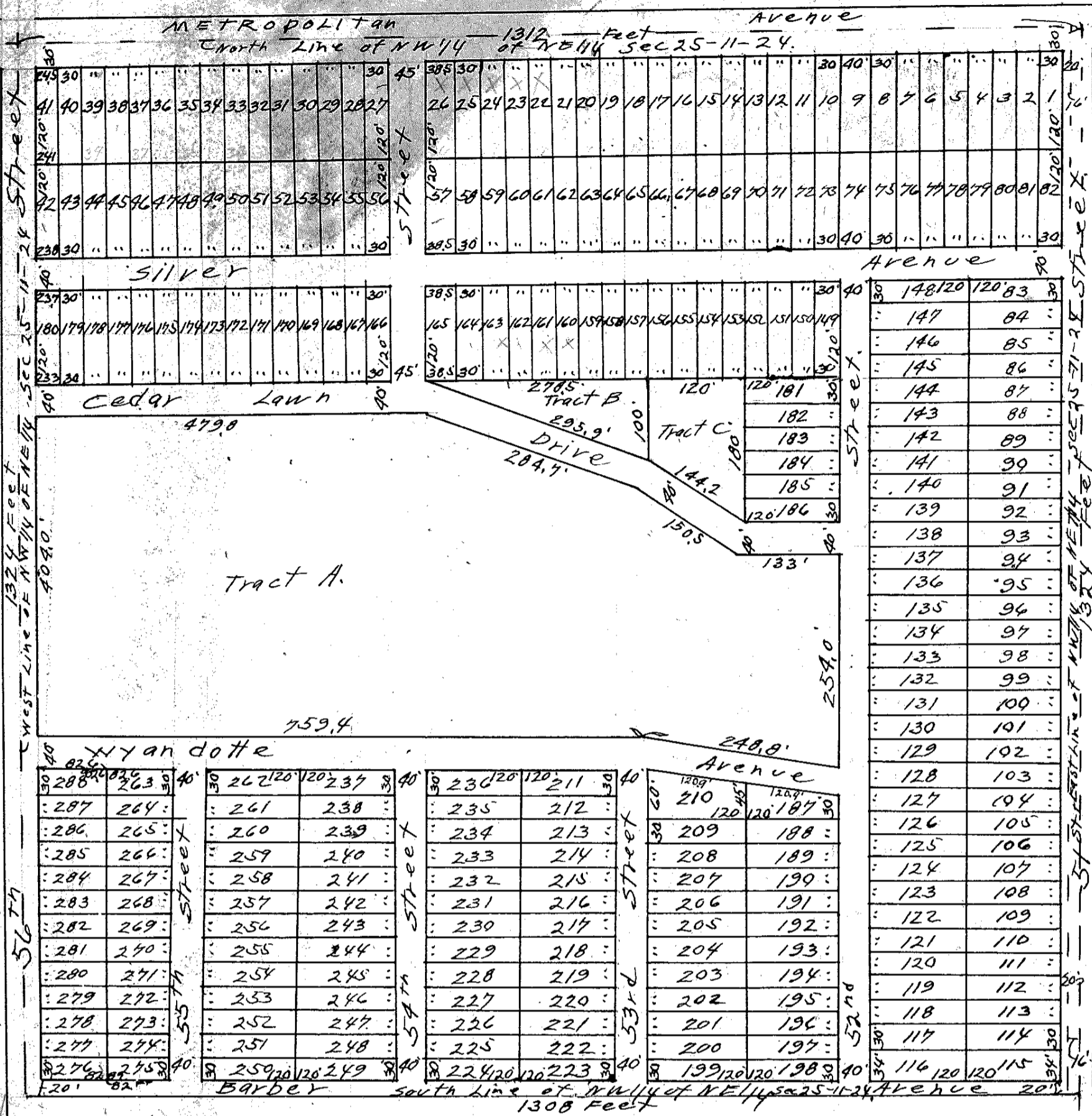


CEDAR LAWN
