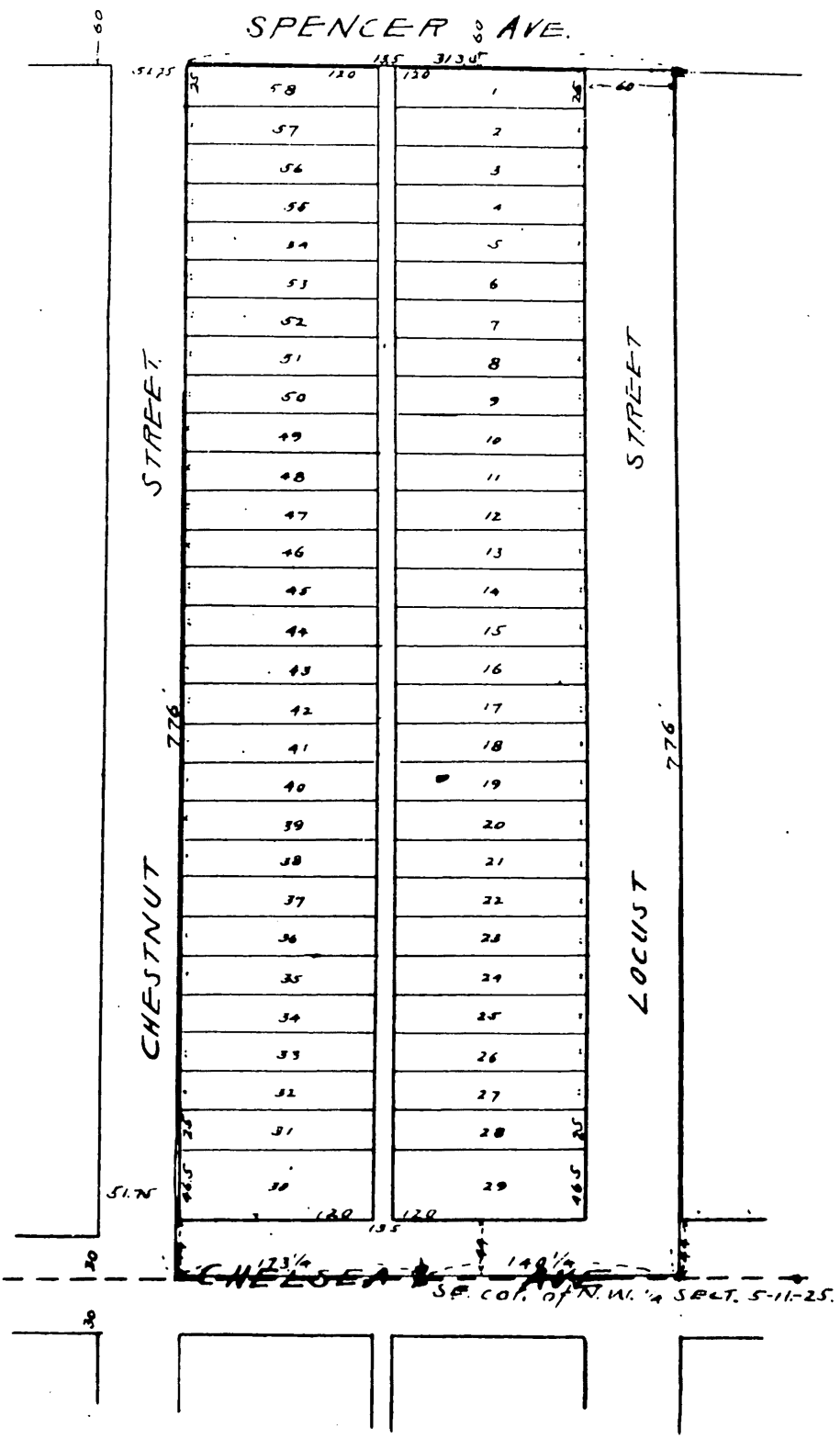


CROWN HILL

to-wit: Beginning at the South-east (S.E.) corner of the North West Quarter (N.W. 1/4)
of Section five (5) township eleven (11) range twenty-four (25) Thence east one
hundred forty and one fourth feet (140 1/4) Thence North seven hundred
seventy-six (776) feet. Thence West three hundred thirteen and one half
(313 1/2) feet. Thence South seven hundred seventy six (776) feet. Thence
East one hundred seventy three and one fourth (173 1/4) feet to place of
beginning and intending to describe Block fourteen (14) by engineers
Plat of Spencer Place.
