


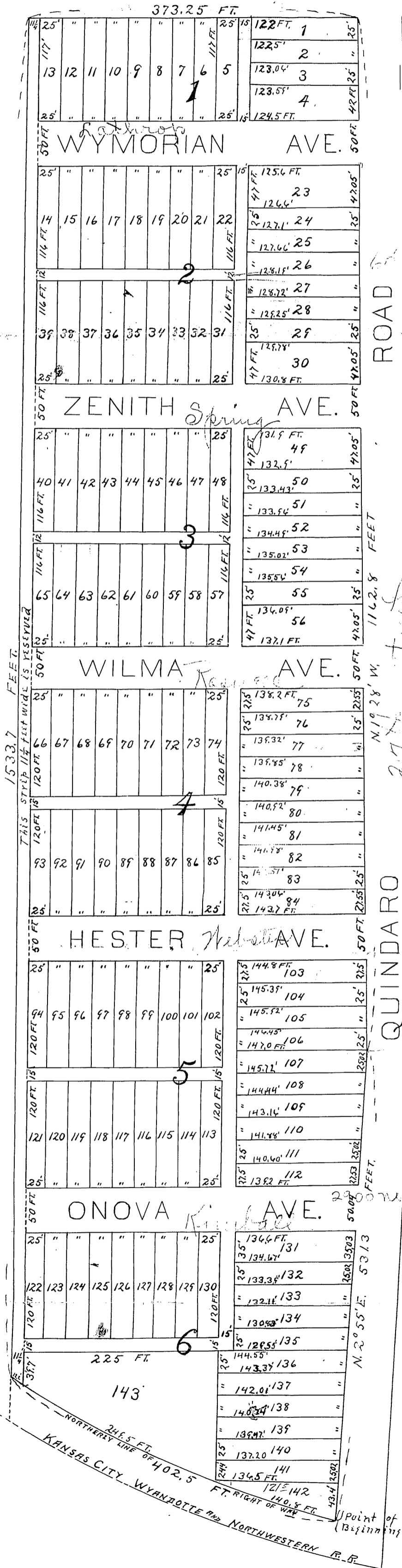
ELLIS PARK

Know all men by these presents, that the THOMSON LAND COMPANY, a corporation, is the owner of the following described property, to wit:-

Beginning at the point of intersection of the east line of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 19S, Range, 25E; with the northerly line of the right of way of the Kansas City, Wyandotte and Northwestern Railroad, said point being four hundred seventy-three (473) feet north of the Southeast Corner of said N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31; Thence N. $2^{\circ}55'$ E. five hundred thirty-one and three tenths (531.3) feet; Thence N. $1^{\circ}28'$ W. eleven hundred sixty-two and eight tenths (1162.8) feet; Thence west three hundred seventy-three and twenty-five hundredths (373.25) feet; Thence south fifteen hundred thirty-three and seven tenths (1533.7) feet to a point on the northerly line of the right of way of the Kansas City, Wyandotte and Northwestern Railroad; Thence Southeasterly along said line of right of way four hundred two and five tenths feet (402.5) to point of beginning.

The owners of the above described property have caused the same to be subdivided in the manner shown on the plat, which subdivision shall be known as "ELLIS PARK ADDITION."

All Avenues and alleys or parts thereof, as marked and shown on the accompanying Plat are hereby dedicated to and for public use forever.

The lands reserved for sale by The Thomson Land Company, a corporation, are shown upon the accompanying Plat as BLOCKS, numbered from 1 to 6 in large black figures; and lots numbered from one (1) to one hundred forty-three (143) inclusive, in small black figures.

The length and width of each and every Avenue and Alley, or part thereof; and the exact size of each and every Lot is shown upon the accompanying plat, and reference is made thereto.
