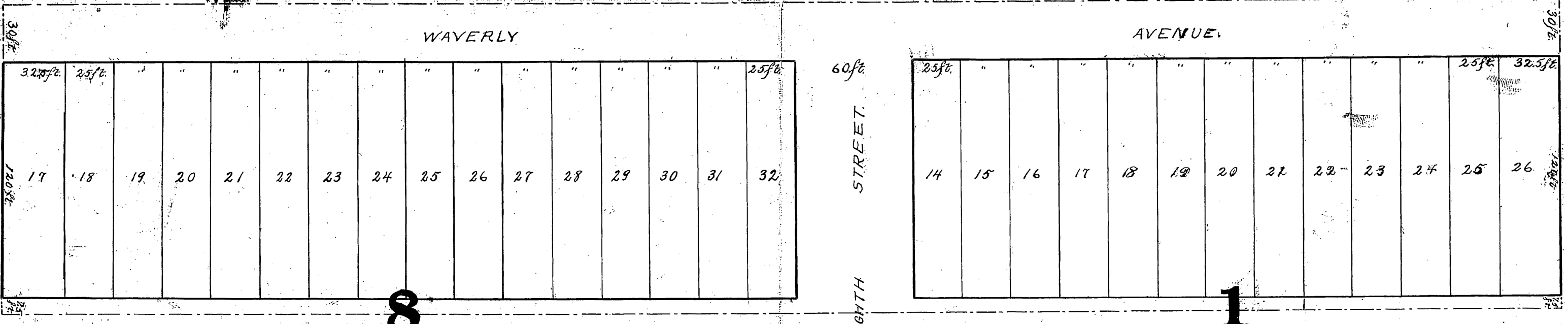


GORDON PLACE.

—Description—

Commencing seven and five tenths (7.5) feet North of the Northwest corner of Lot Sixteen (16), Block eight (8) in Gordon Place as per plat on record. Thence North one hundred fifty seven and five tenths (157.5) feet; Thence East eight hundred and twenty five one hundredths (800.25) feet; Thence South one hundred fifty seven and five tenths (157.5) feet; Thence West to beginning.

—Dedication—

The parcels of ground intended for sale on this plat, are designated by numbers as Lots in Blocks. The Lots being numbered with small black figures, and the Blocks with large black figures. The precise length and breadth of each lot is set forth on this plat in feet and decimal parts thereof.
