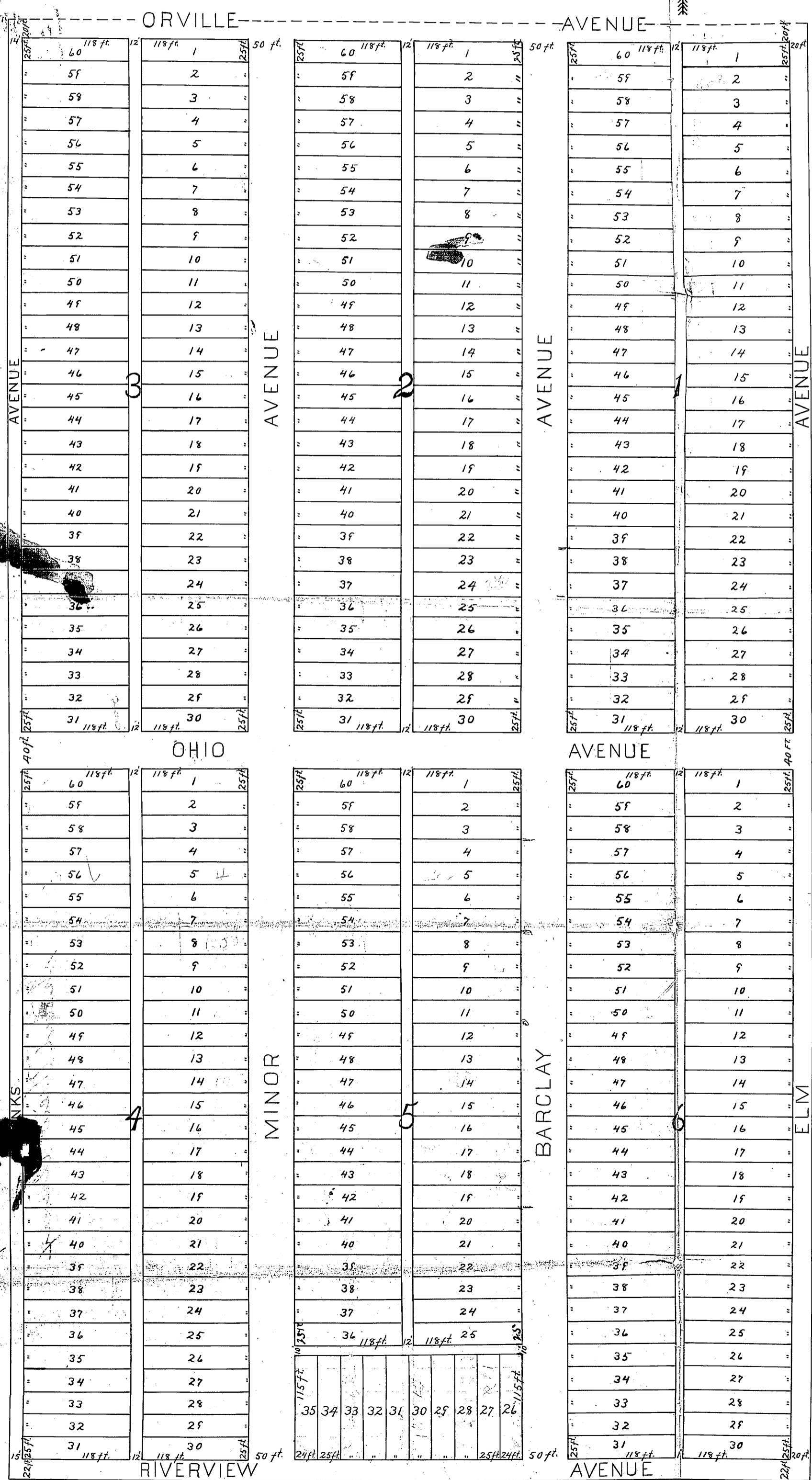

This Plat of "GRANDVIEW ANNEX" covers land in Section 8, Township 11, S., Range 25, E., Wyandotte County, Kansas, described as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at a point four hundred thirty-nine (439) feet east of the Northwest corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 8, Township 11, S., Range 25, E., Thence South fifteen hundred eighty-two (1582) feet; Thence East eight hundred seventy-nine (879) feet; Thence north fifteen hundred eighty-two (1582) feet; Thence West eight hundred seventy-eight (878) feet, to point of beginning.

**DEDICATION**  
The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as Blocks and Lots in GRANDVIEW ANNEX, the Blocks being numbered with large red figures, and the Lots with small black figures. The parcels of ground in the Subdivision reserved for public use are Avenues and Alleys, the name, extent, and direction of all such Avenues and Alleys are designated on the Plat, and they are hereby dedicated to public use as such.
