

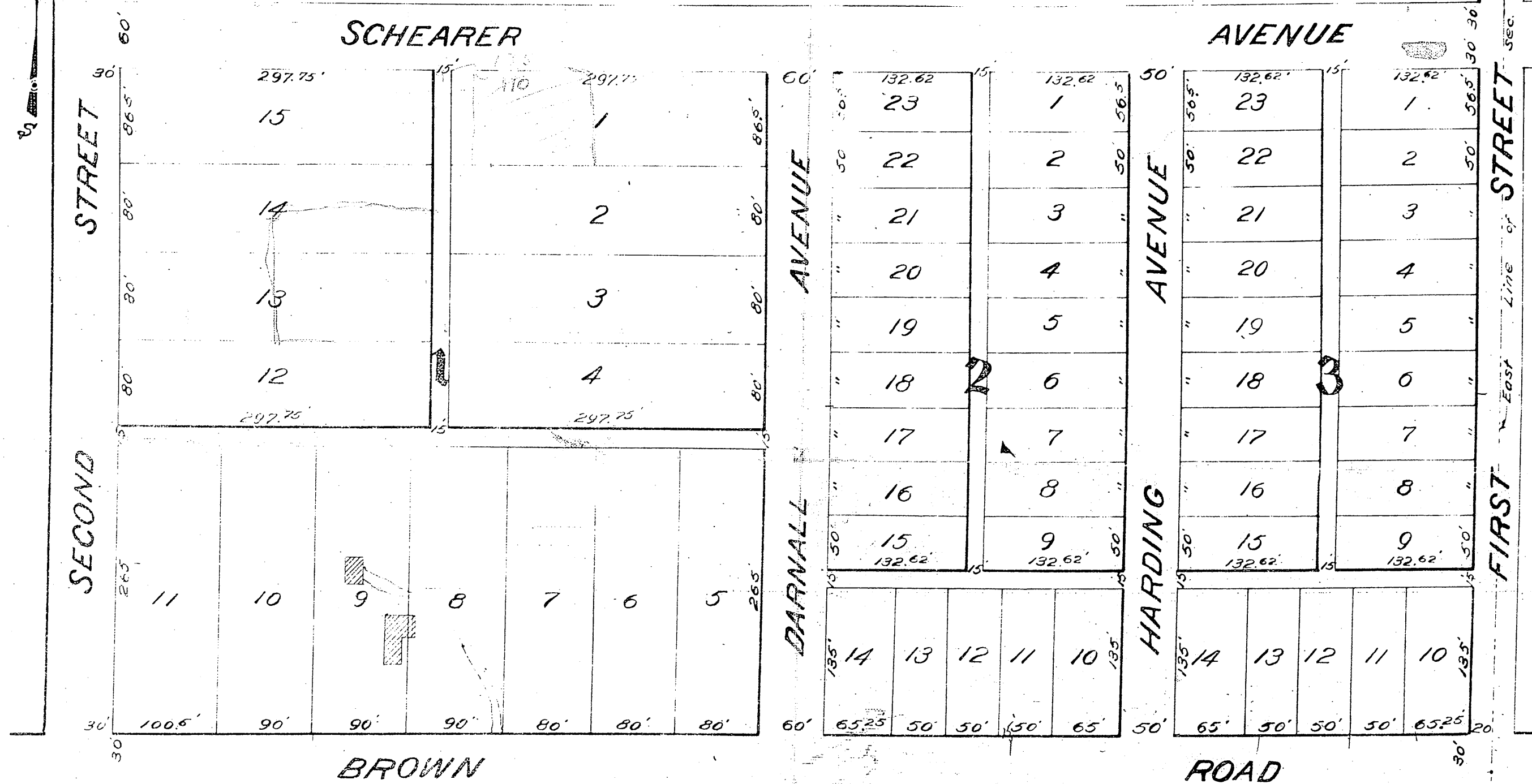
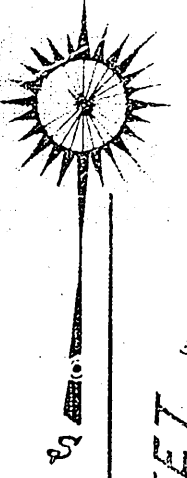

Township 11 Range 25. Also the South thirty (30) feet of the North  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the South  
East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29 Township 11 Range 25.

The lands reserved for sale are lots and blocks the numbers and dimensions of which are  
marked on the accompanying plot and shall hereafter be known and described as lots and blocks in  
Green Ridge.
