Description

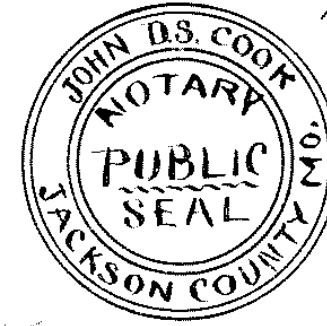
The land on which this addition is platted is the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section 10, Township 11 South, Range 25 East, containing 10 acres.

The lots in this addition are each of a frontage of 30 feet and of a depth of 125 feet in Blocks B and C, and lot 1 to 5 incl in Block A, and lots 1 to 15 incl in Block C, are 123 feet in depth, and lots 6 to 10 incl in Block A and lots 16 to 30 incl in Block C are 126 feet in depth. 150 feet West of East line is given a street of 60 feet width called Meridian Street. On the North Side Ella Street is given a width of forty feet, on the South Side one half of Ohio Street 30 feet wide and St. Louis Street of a width of Sixty feet runs East and West between Blocks A & B and C and D of Sixty feet width. Alleys in Blocks A and C being 17 feet wide and in Blocks B and D being 20 feet wide, as designated above and platted herewith. Said Streets and Alleys are hereby dedicated to public use as such.
