This is a subdivision of all the following described tracts, pieces and parcels of land lying and situate in the County of Jackson, Missouri to wit: Commencing at a point in the center of Quindaro Road 363 feet West and 1527 feet South of the North West corner of the N.E. quarter of Sec 32 Twp 10, Range 25 thence South 83 1/2 feet thence South 84° 30' East 1070 feet to the South West corner of the Ellen M. Browne tract thence North 17° East 594.7 feet to center of Quindaro Road thence North Westerly to the place of beginning said land consisting of blocks 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 of Brownes Park an addition to Kansas City, Kansas, and of all lands that have accrued thereto by the vacation of contiguous streets and alleys excepting lots 4 and 14 in Block 3 and also excepting lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 11, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 in said Block 2.

The undersigned proprietors of the above described tract of land have caused the same to be subdivided in the manner represented on the accompanying plat which subdivision and plat shall hereafter be known as Hazelrose.
