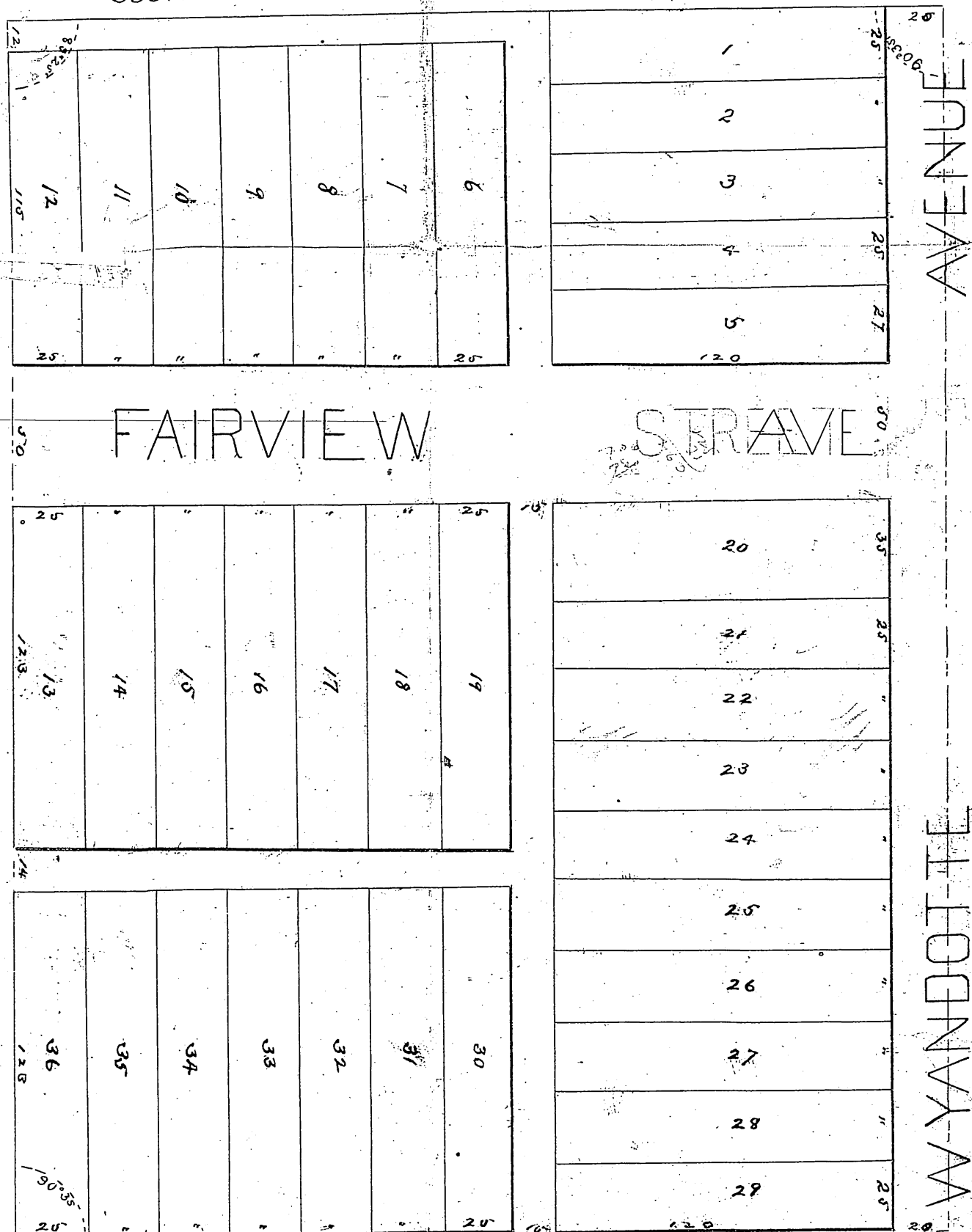


Plat of HUSTED PLACE

Thence West twenty (20) poles Thence South twenty eight (28) poles Thence East twenty (20) poles to the east line of said section sixteen (16) Thence North along said line twenty eight (28) poles to the place of beginning, containing 3 1/2 acres.

Stumpf his wife owners of the above described land do hereby dedicate and convey to the public for their use the streets and alleys named and designated within the foregoing description according to the accompanying plat and it is hereby expressly understood that no rights or privileges, what ever are hereby granted or dedicated excepting the simple easement of travel over said streets, avenues and alleys.
