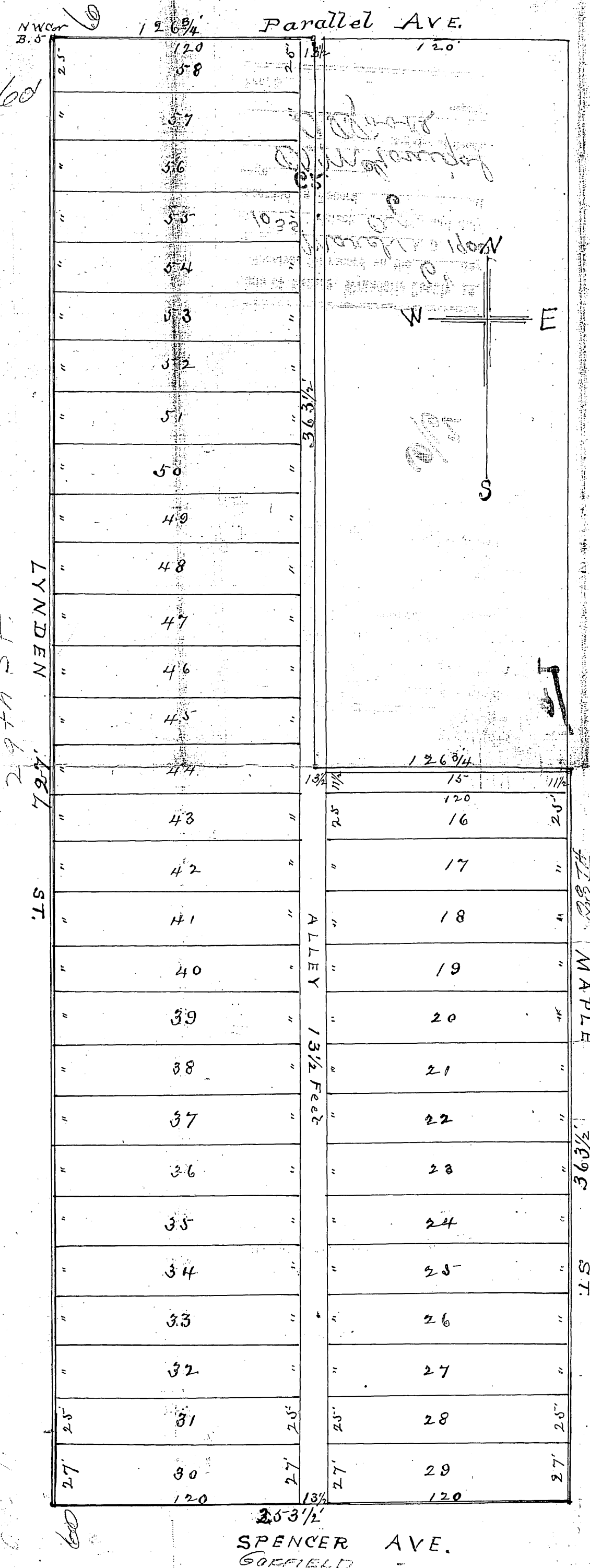


RESURVEY OF PART OF BLOCK 5. KENSINGTON.
