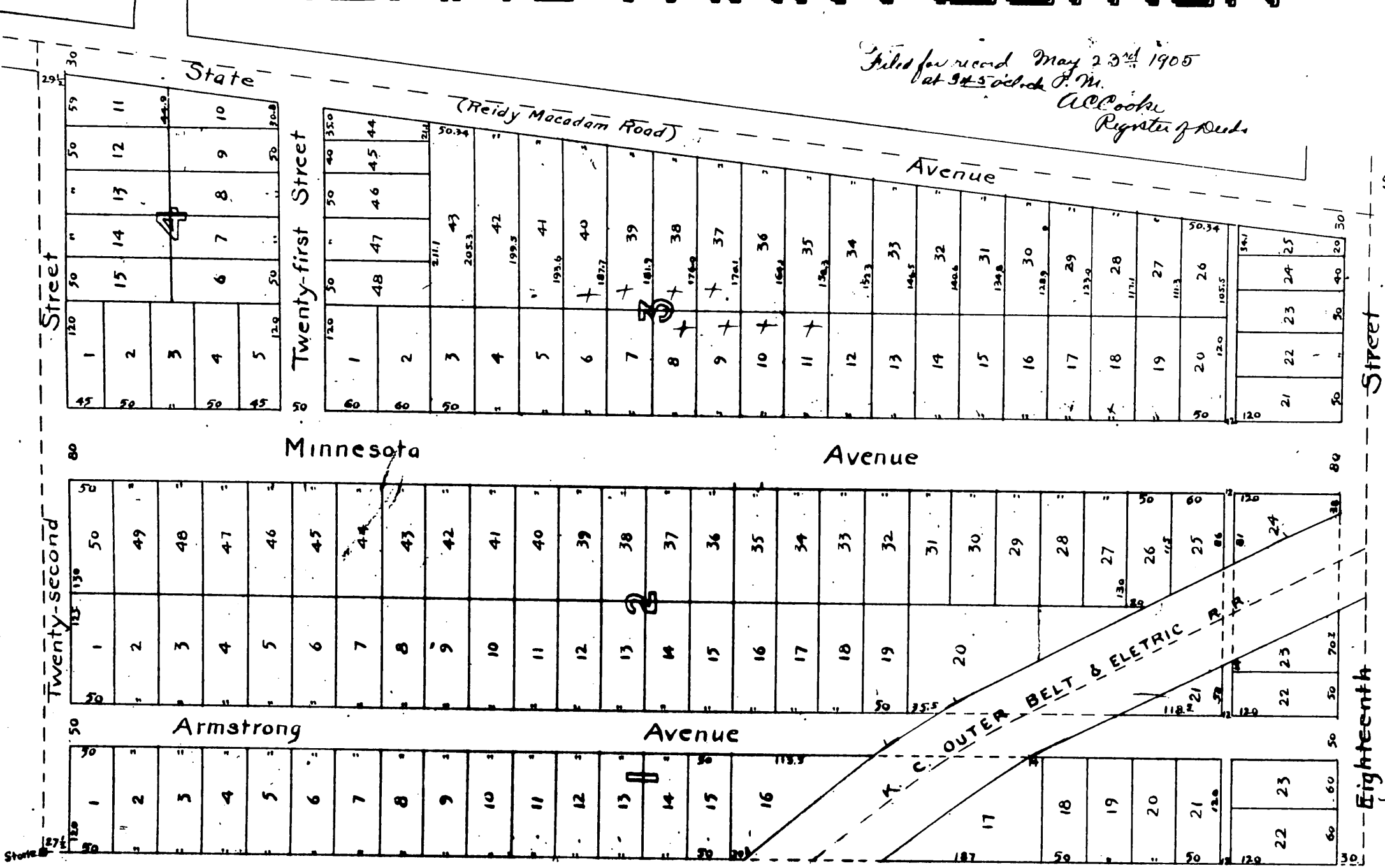


# KERR'S PARK ADDITION
