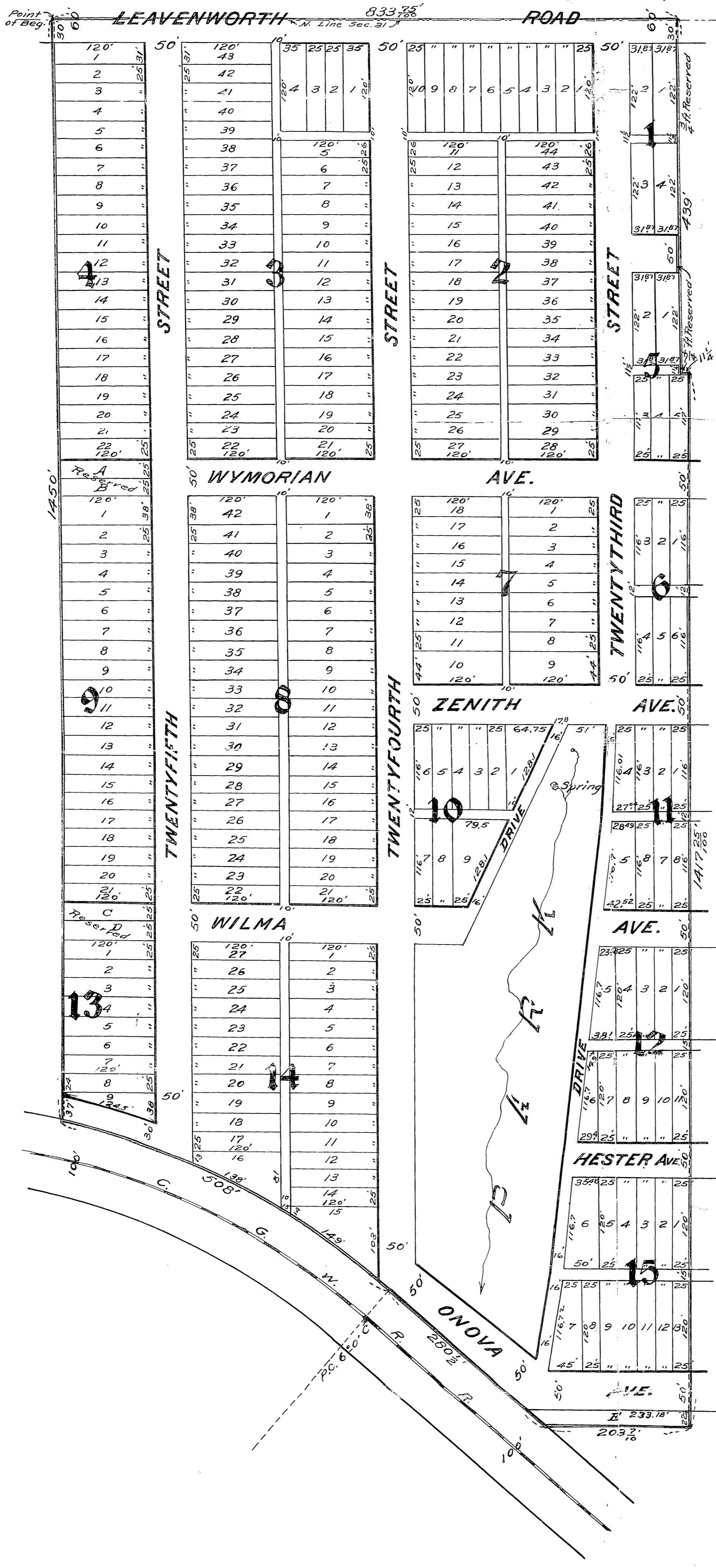

This plat of Leland Place covers land in Wyandotte County Kansas described as follows to wit:

Beginning at a point 88 poles East of the North West corner of the North East quarter of Section 31 Township 10 Range 25 thence South fourteen hundred and fifty (1450) feet to the Northerly line of the Right of Way of the Kansas City Wyandotte and North-Western Railway, now known as the Chicago Great Western Railway; thence Southeasterly along the Northerly line of the said Railway on a curve with a radius of 1005 feet a distance of 508 feet; thence on a tangent to said curve a distance of Two hundred and Eighty and one-half (280½) feet; thence East Two hundred and three and Seven-tenths (203¾) feet; thence North Fourteen hundred and seventeen and twenty-five (1417²⁵/₁₀₀) feet; thence West eleven and one-quarter (11¼) feet; thence North Four Hundred and thirty nine (439) feet; thence West Eight hundred and thirty-three and seventy-five hundredths (833⁷⁵/₁₀₀) feet to the beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are lots and blocks the lots are numbered in small and the blocks in large figures. Lots A, B, C, D, and E and the tract designated as Park are hereby reserved.

The lands intended for public use are Streets, Avenues, Alleys and Drives and the same are hereby dedicated to public use as such.
