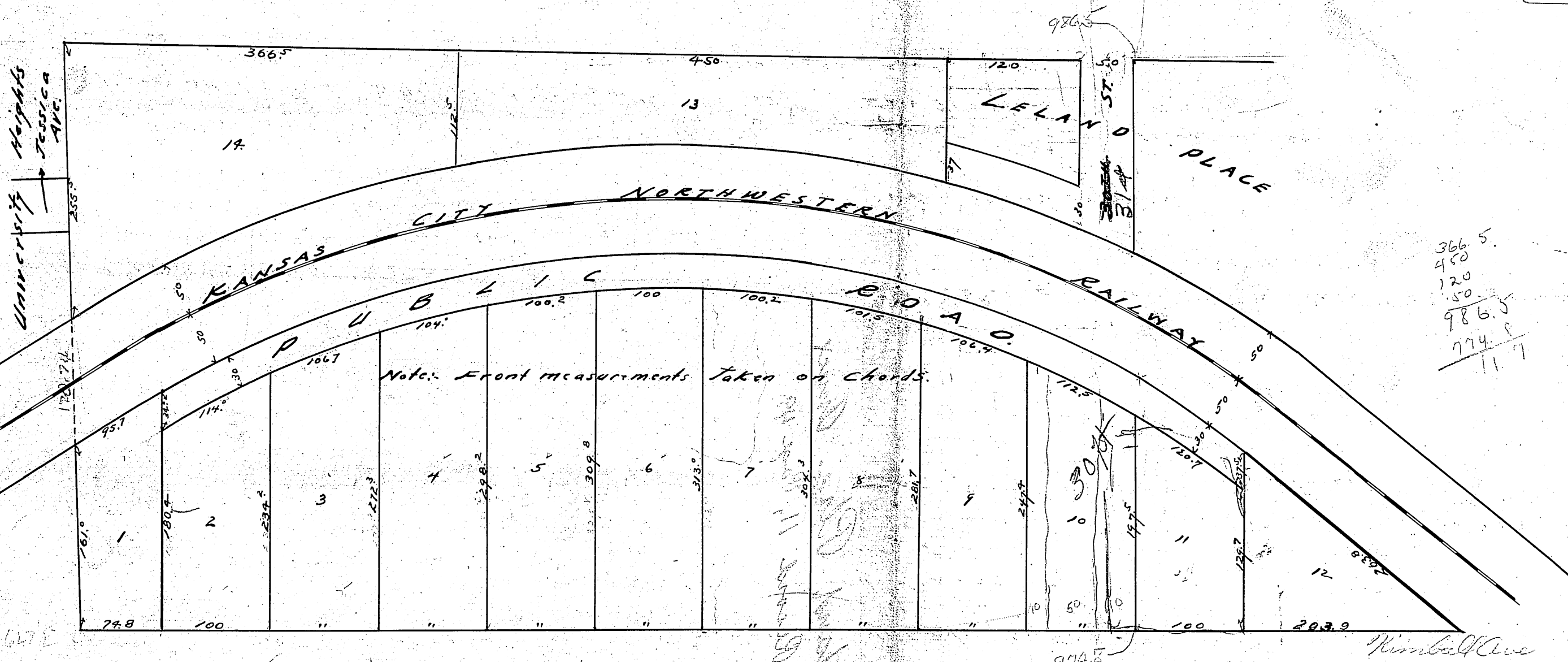


# Leland Place Annex.
