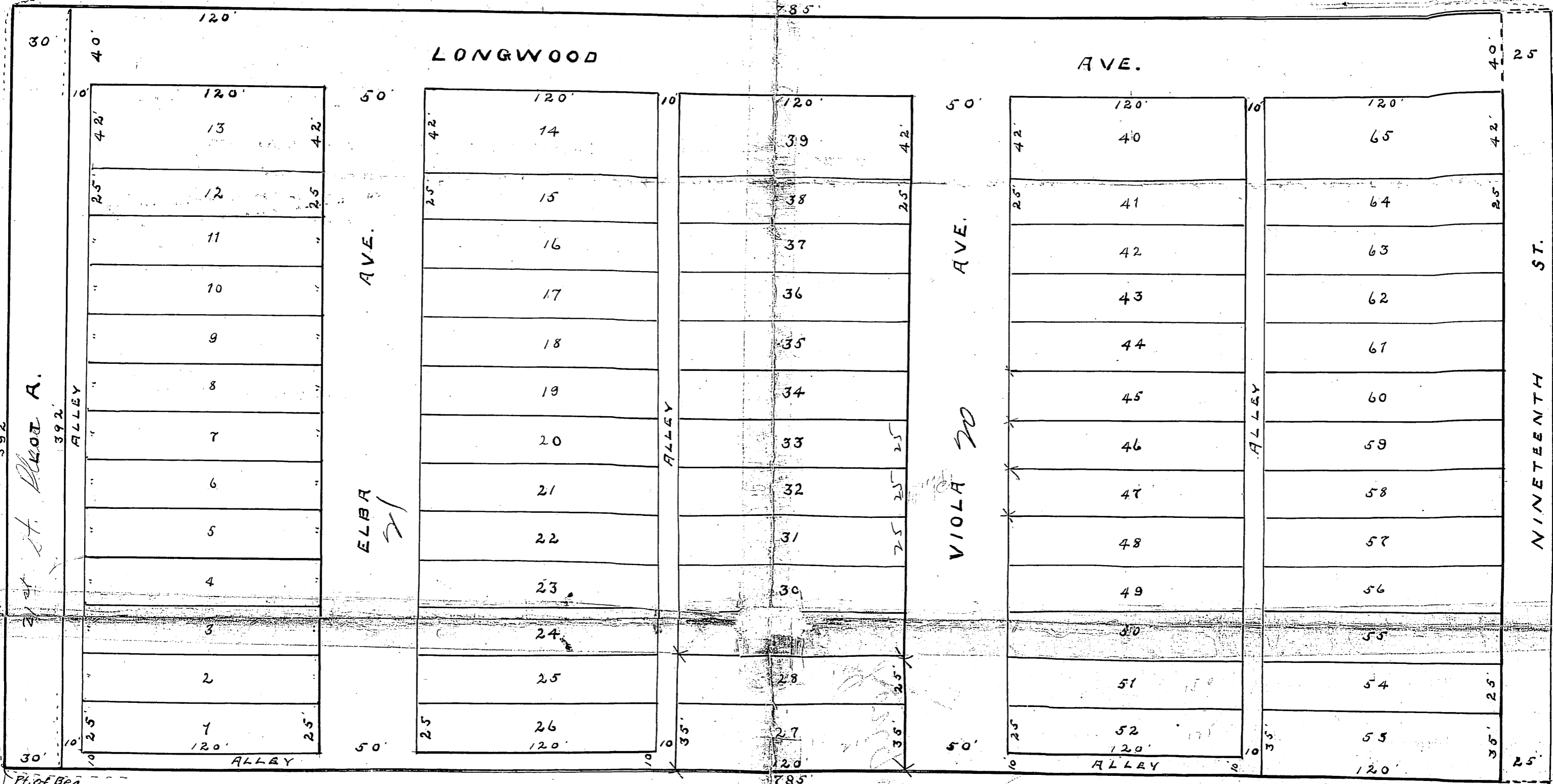


# LONGWOOD ANNEX

THIS PLAT of LONGWOOD ANNEX covers land in Wyandotte County Kansas, described as follows to wit:—  
 Beginning at a point eleven hundred and forty-eight (1148) feet west and twenty six hundred thirty-nine and five tenths (2639<sup>5</sup>/<sub>10</sub>) feet north of the south east corner of the south west quarter of Section 32-Twp. 10-R. 25; thence north three hundred and ninety two (392) feet; thence east seven hundred and eighty-five (785) feet; thence south three hundred and ninety-two (392) feet; thence west seven hundred and eighty-five (785) feet to beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are designated by letter "A" and numbers from 1 to 65 and will hereafter be known as lots in Longwood Annex. The parcels of ground intended for public use are streets, avenues and alleys, the name extent and direction of which are shown on this plat and they are hereby dedicated to public use as such.
