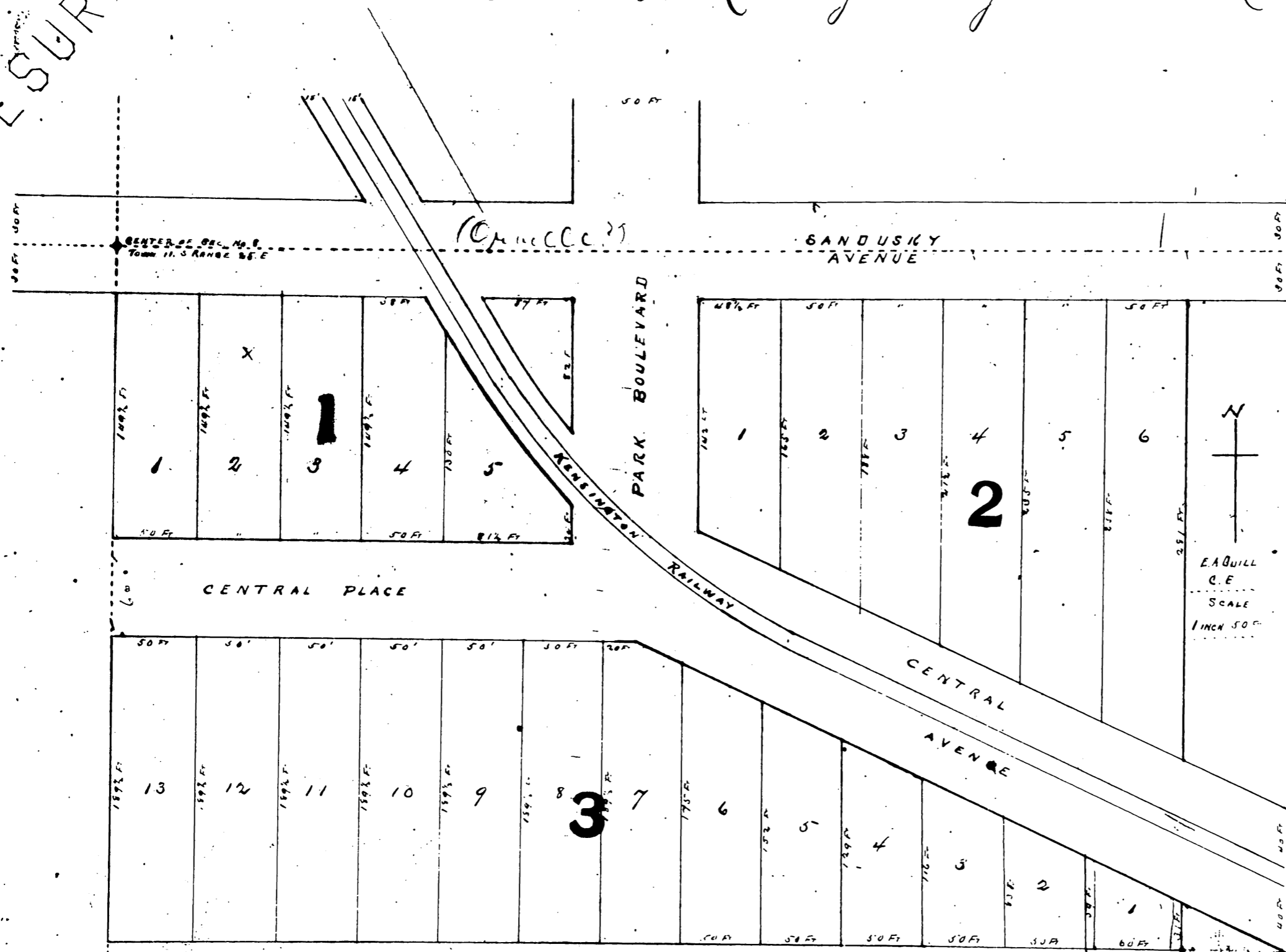


RESURVEY OF

Resurvey of Maple Leaf.
The lands included in this Plat are described as follows.

Commencing at the center of Section number Eight (8) Township Eleven (11) Range Twenty five (25) East in the County of Wyandotte and State of Kansas. Thence East Forty (40) rods. Thence South Twenty six (26) rods. Thence West Forty (40) Rods. Thence North Twenty Six (26) rods to the beginning. Excepting therefrom the right of way of the Kensington Railway Company. All Streets and Alleways as shown on said Plat are dedicated to the Public use forever. The land reserved for sale are Blocks Number One (1) Two (2) and Three (3), and includes their several subdivisions into lots of the dimensions as shown in said Plat.
