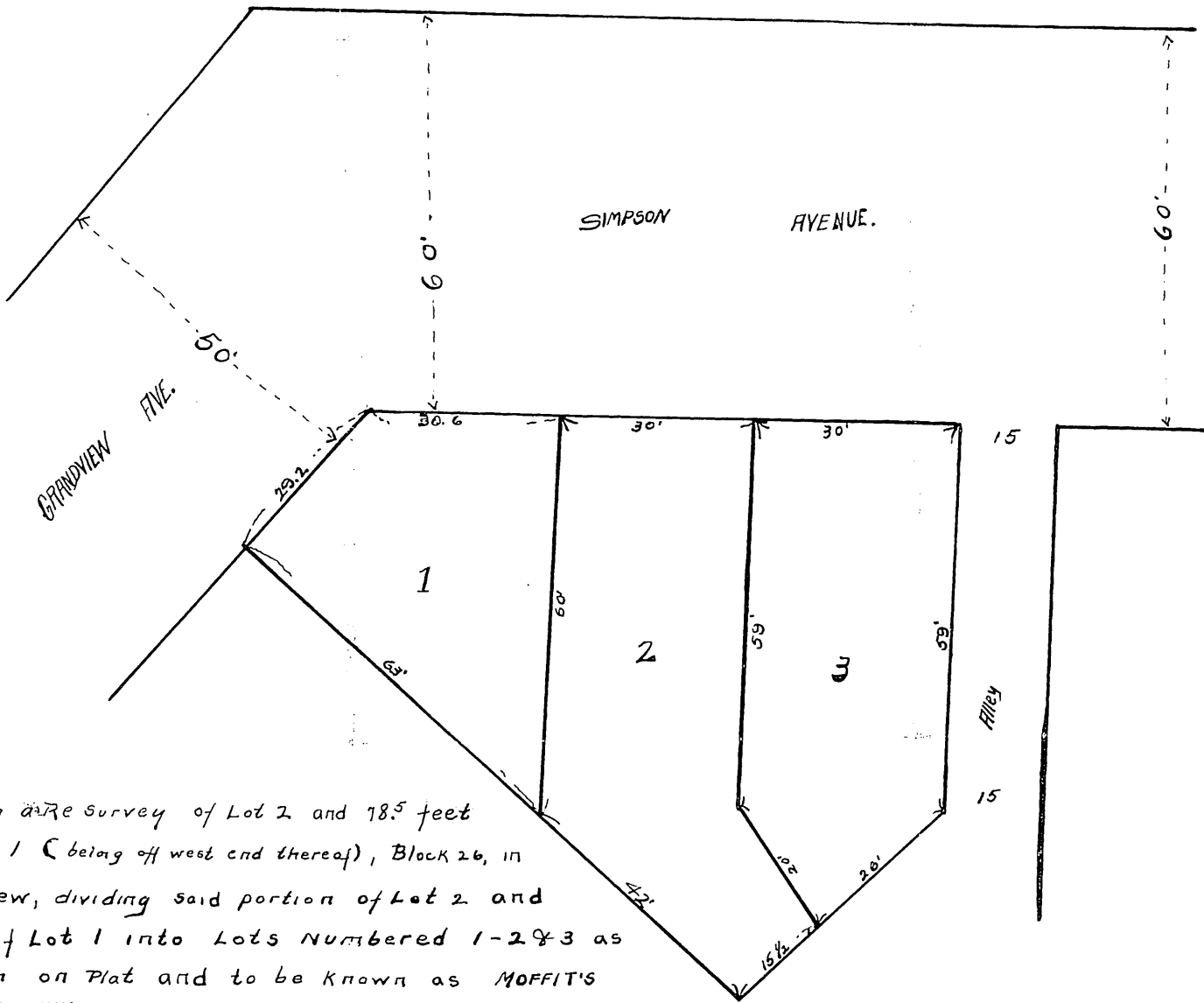


MOFFITT'S RESURVEY OF PART LOT 1 & BLOCK 26, RIVERVIEW.
