

This Plot of OAK PARK, an Addition to Kansas City, Kansas, Covers land in WYANDOTTE Co. KANSAS Described as follows, to-wit:- Commencing at a point three hundred sixty-three (363) feet west of the Southeast corner of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 10, S., Range 25, E.; Thence west twelve hundred forty-six and five tenths (1246.5) feet; Thence N. 5° 0' W. five hundred thirty-three (533) feet; Thence east six (6) feet; Thence N. 3° 15' E. six hundred seventeen and five tenths (617.5) feet; Thence east thirteen hundred nineteen (1319) feet; Thence south six hundred three and four tenths (603.4) feet to the centerline of the County Road; Thence S. 13° 5' W. two hundred thirty-four (234) feet; Thence south three hundred ten and four tenths (310.4) feet to beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are shown upon the accompanying PLAT as BLOCKS and LOTS; the BLOCKS being designated by large black figures, and the LOTS being designated by small black figures; The location and exact size of each and every LOT is shown upon the accompanying PLAT and reference made thereto.

The parcels of ground reserved for public use are known as AVENUES, Streets, Alleys, and the PARKWAY, and all such AVENUES, Streets, Alleys, and PARKWAY as same are marked or described upon the accompanying PLAT, are hereby dedicated to the public for use as such.
