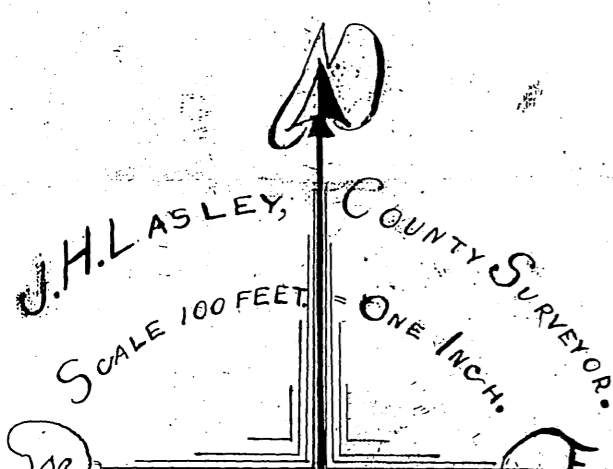
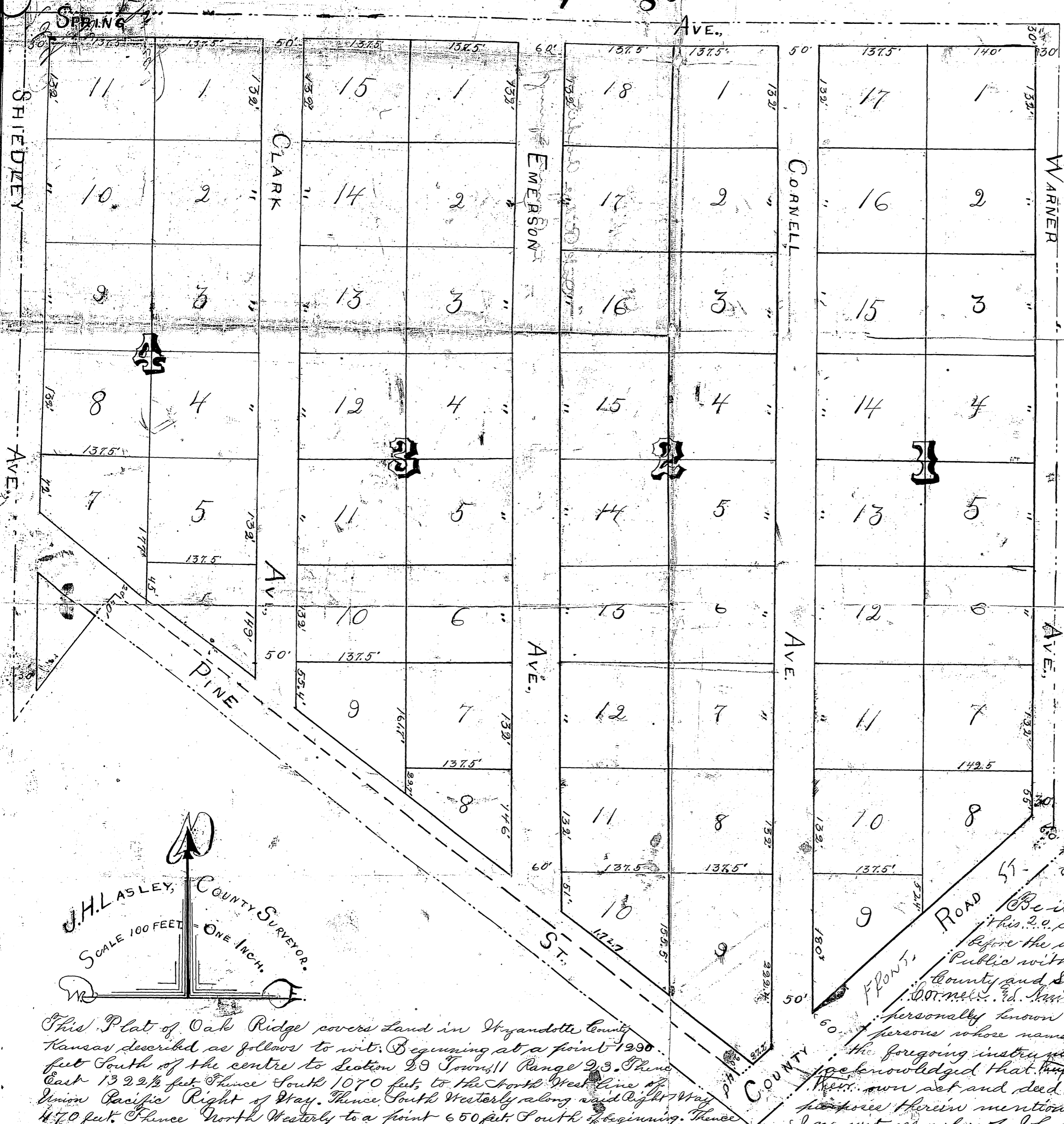


Oak Ridge Addition, to Bonner Springs.



This Plat of Oak Ridge covers land in Wyandotte County Kansas described as follows to wit: Beginning at a point 1290 feet South of the centre to Section 29 Town 11 Range 23. Thence East 1322 1/2 feet Thence South 1070 feet to the North West line of Union Pacific Right of Way. Thence South Westerly along said Right Way 470 feet. Thence North Westerly to a point 650 feet South of beginning. Thence North 650 feet to beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as Blocks and Lots in Oak Ridge. The blocks being numbered with large blue figures, and the lots with small black figures. The parcels of ground reserved for public use are Streets, and Avenues. The names, extent, and direction of all such Streets and Avenues are designated on Plat and are reserved for Public purposes, as such. All lots intended for sale, are set forth, and described by numbers in Blocks. The precise length and width of each lot in feet and decimal portions thereof is set forth on this Plat in small black figures.
