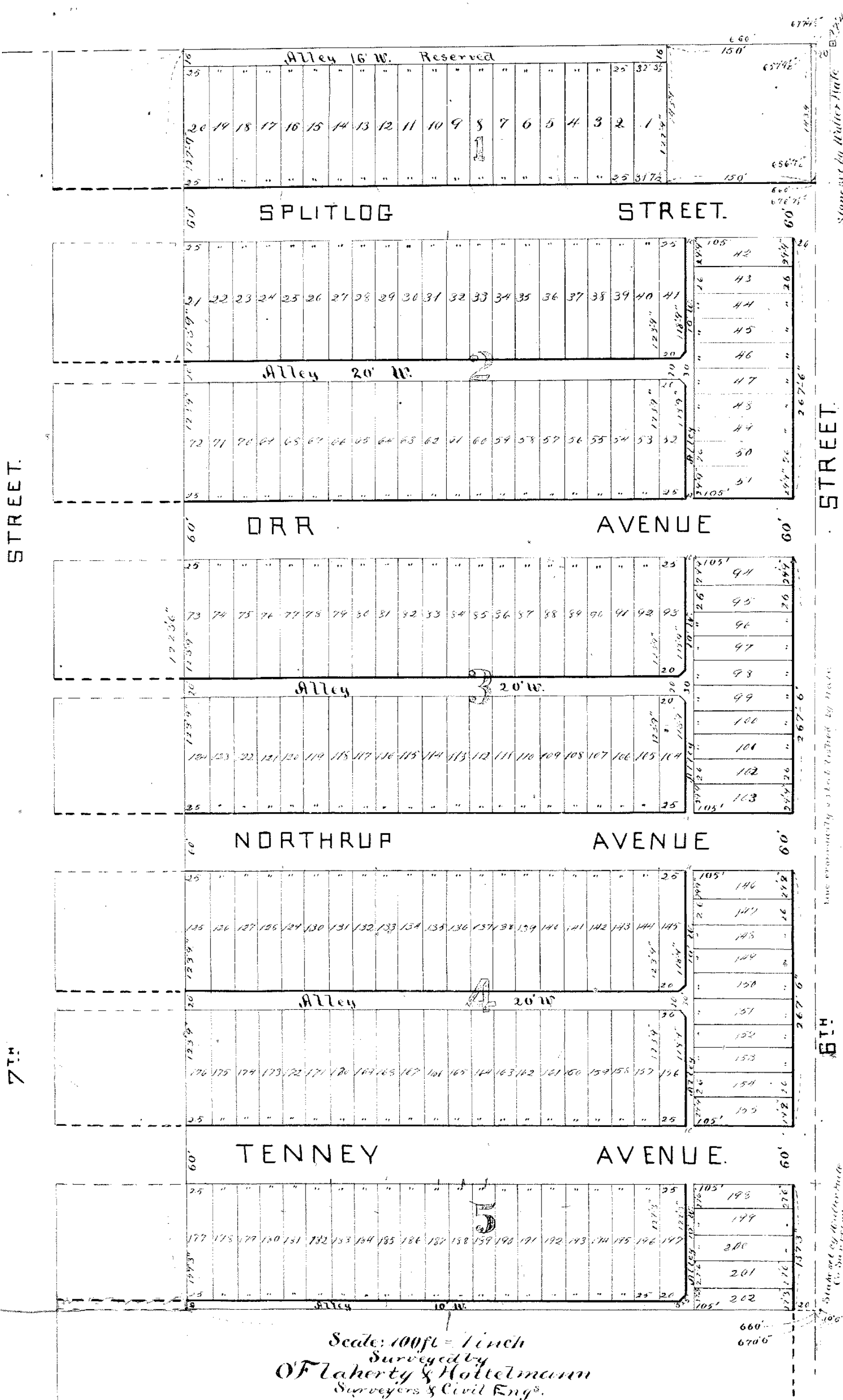


ORR'S ADDITION

TO

WYANDOTTE

Being a Sub-division of the West half of the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Sec. 10 Township 11 S. Range 25 East.

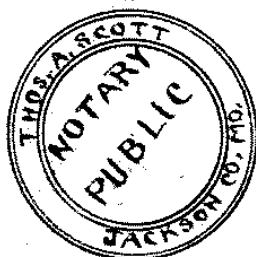


The undersigned proprietor of all that portion of the West half of the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section 10, Township 11 South Range 25 East in Wyandotte County, excepting a lot of ground containing a front of 143 feet 9 inches on the east line of said West half by an average depth West, with the same width of 153 feet being bounded on the north line of said West half and on the South by the north line of Splitlog Street, have caused the same to be subdivided in the manner as represented on this plat and which subdivision shall hereafter be known as, "Orr's Addition to Wyandotte." A strip of land 60 feet wide for Splitlog Avenue extending from the prolongation of the east line of Block 2 west to the west line of said West half also, a strip of land 60 feet wide for Orr Avenue extending from the prolongation of the east line of Block 3 to the west line of said West half, also a strip of land 60 feet wide for Northrup Avenue extending from the prolongation of the east line of Block 4 to the west line of said West half, also a strip of land 60 feet wide for Tenney Avenue extending from the prolongation of the east line of Block 5 to the west line of said West half, also all the alleys as represented and coloured brown in blocks 2, 3, 4 and 5 are hereby dedicated to public use forever. A strip of land 16 feet wide lying immediately north of and adjoining lots 11020 of block 1, and also a strip of land 20 feet wide extending from the south line of said West half, north, to the north line of Splitlog Street and bounded on the East by the east line of said West half are hereby reserved by the proprietor.
