



PARKWOOD

DESCRIPTION COVERING BLOCKS 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11

This plat covers land in Wyandotte County, Kansas, described as follows. Commencing at a point shown hundred fifty-two and six tenths (152.6) feet east and thirteen hundred and twenty (1320) feet north of the center of Section 23, Township 19 S, Range 25 E; thence north thirteen hundred twenty-six and four tenths feet (1326.4), thence west nine hundred two (902) feet; thence south fifteen hundred sixty-six and eight tenths (1566.8) feet; thence east two hundred twenty (270) feet; thence on a curve to the right of a radius of two hundred (200) feet for a distance of eighty-two and four tenths feet (82.4); thence on a curve to the left of a radius of one hundred fifty (150) feet for a distance of one hundred twenty-five and seven tenths (125.7); thence east two hundred nineteen and eight tenths (219.8) feet; thence north two hundred fifty-one and two tenths feet (251.2); thence east two hundred eighteen and two tenths (218.2) feet to point of beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as Blocks and Lots in Parkwood; the blocks with large and the lots with small figures. The parcels of ground reserved for public use are Streets and Avenues. A license to Kansas City, Kansas, or the Parkwood Land Company to build sewers across the rear end of all lots shown on this plat and for such purposes to excavate for a width of three feet across said rear ends of lots is hereby granted. The name, direction and extent of all such streets and avenues are designated on this plat, and such streets and avenues are dedicated to public use as such.
