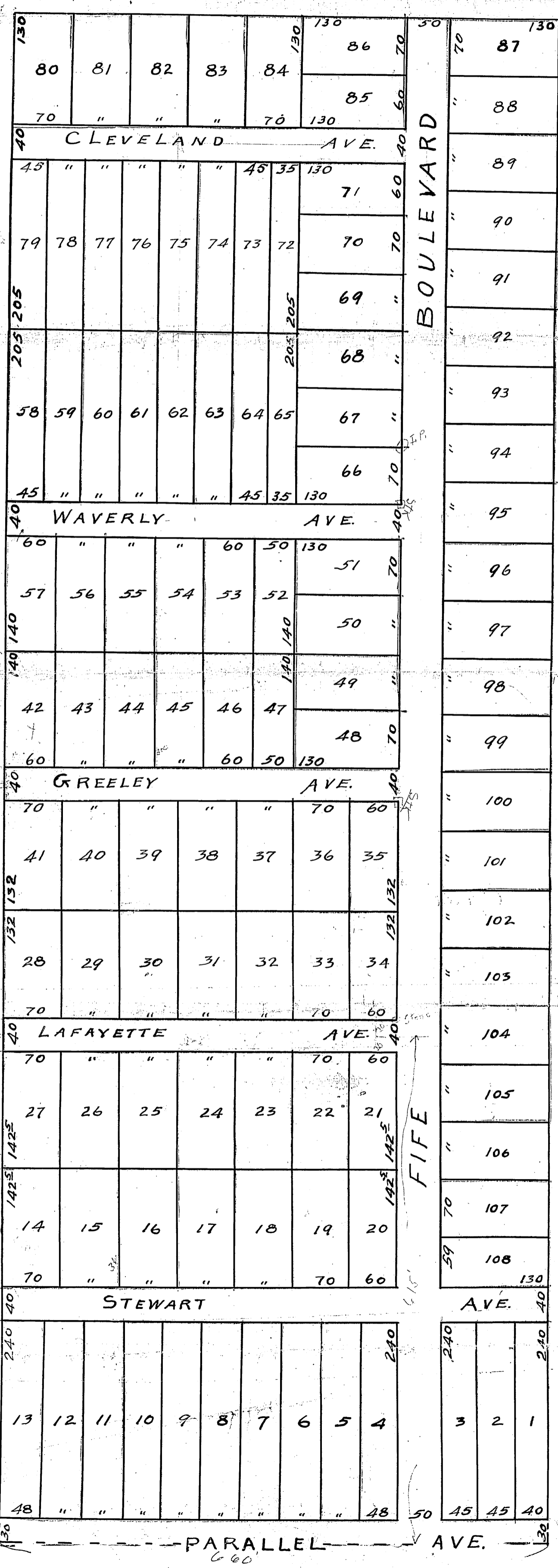


QUEEN'S GARDEN.
