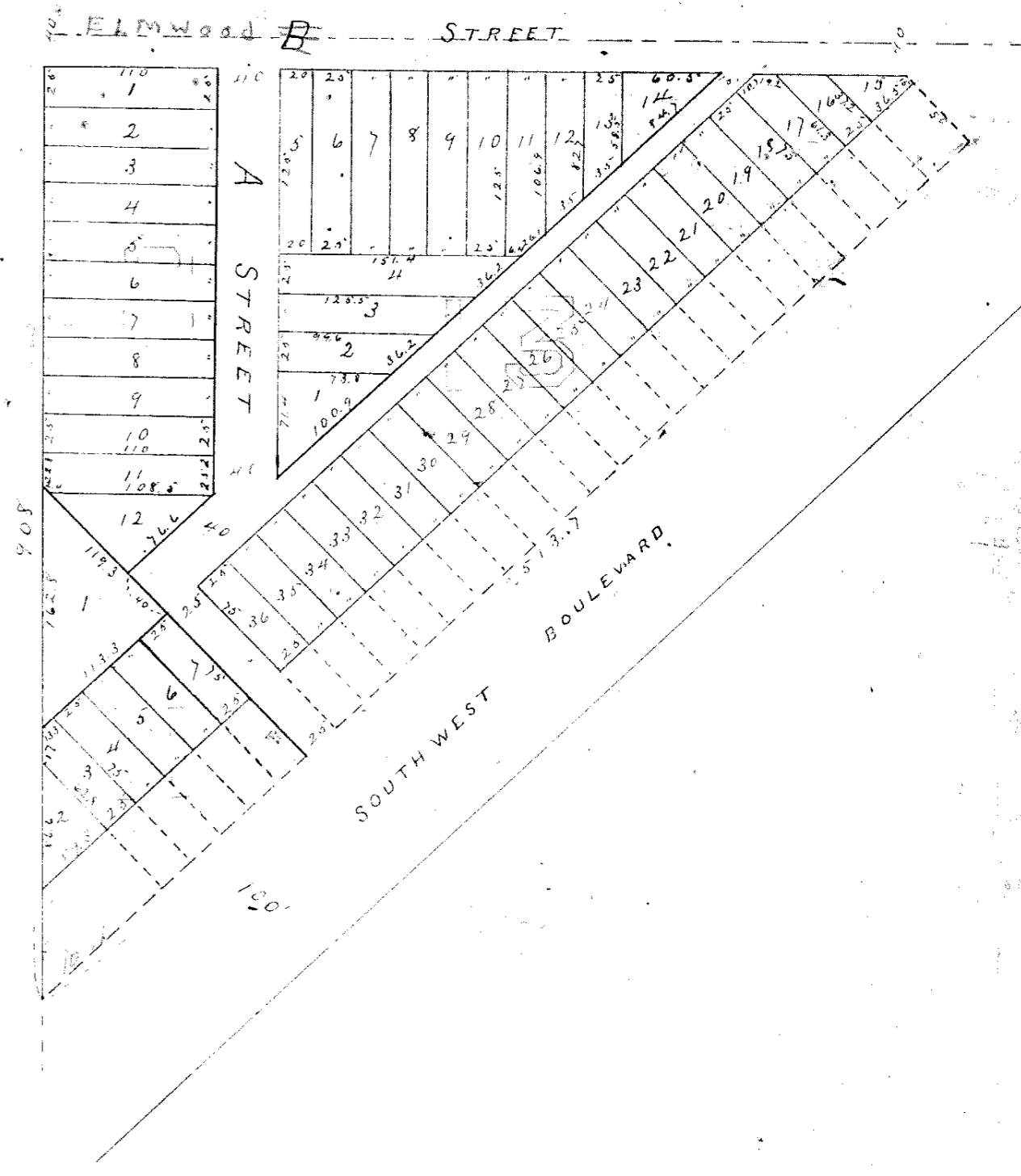
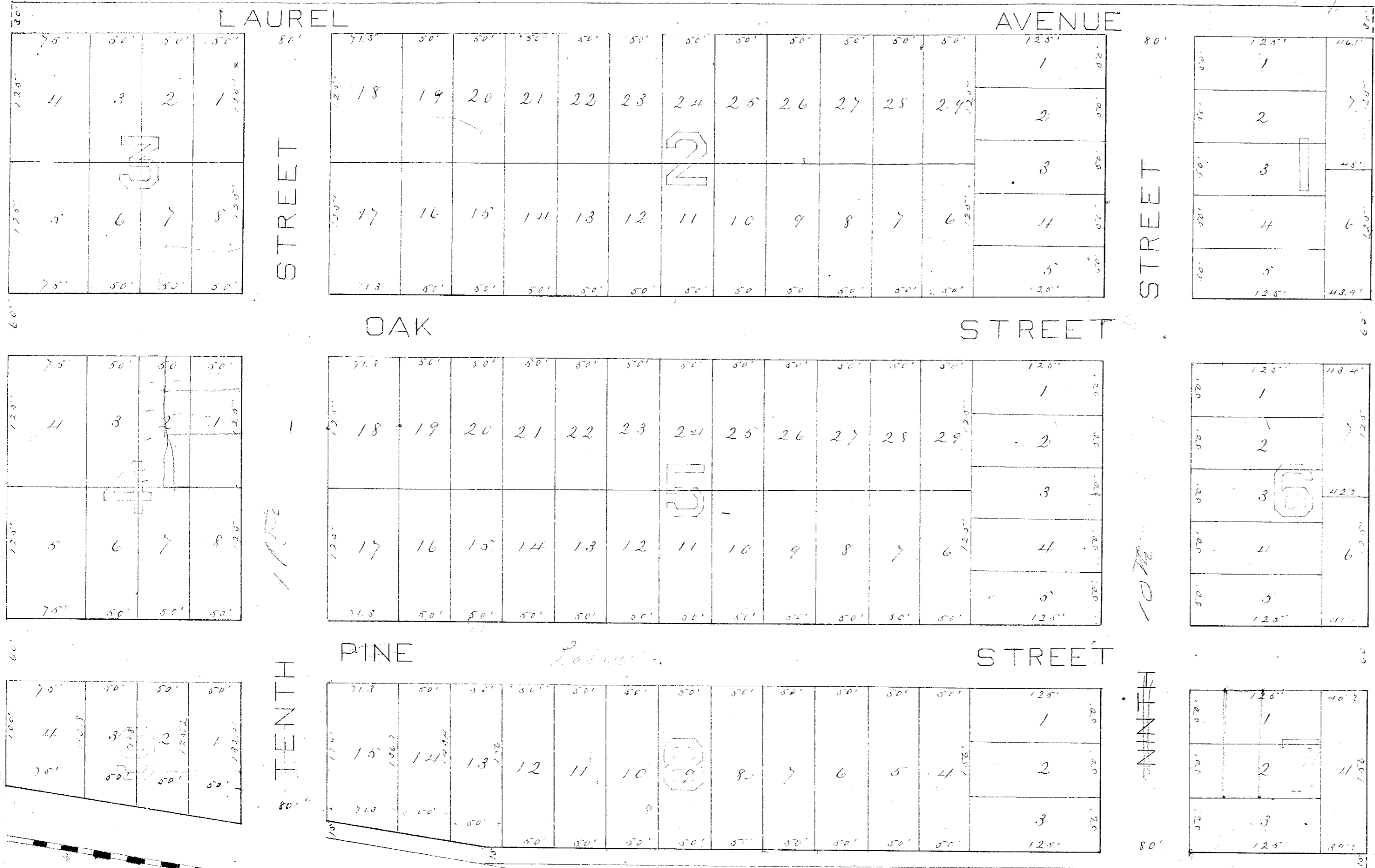

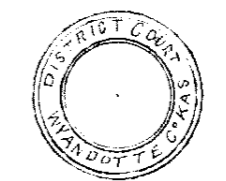

This plat of Rockingham Place covers land in Wyandotte County, Kansas, that bounded to wit: Commencing at a point one hundred and fifty feet and three quarters (153.75) feet East of the North West corner of the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section thirty three (33) Town ten (10) Range twenty five (25) 4th Range East Tenth Meridian and two and four tenths (2.4) feet Thence South Eight hundred and twenty six (826) feet Thence West to Kansas City, Wyandotte the Northwestern Railway right of way thence westerly along said right of way to a point South of beginning thence south to beginning, and the lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as blocks and lots with small black figures. The figures of ground in the subdivisions reserved for public use are Streets, Avenues and Alleys, and the names, extent and direction of all such Streets, Avenues and Alleys are designated on plat and are reserved for public purposes as such.

In Rockingham Place the blocks being numbered with large figures and lots with small black figures. All lots intended for sale are set forth and described by numbers in blocks, the precise length and width of each lot in feet and decimal fractions thereof is set forth on the plat in small black figures.
