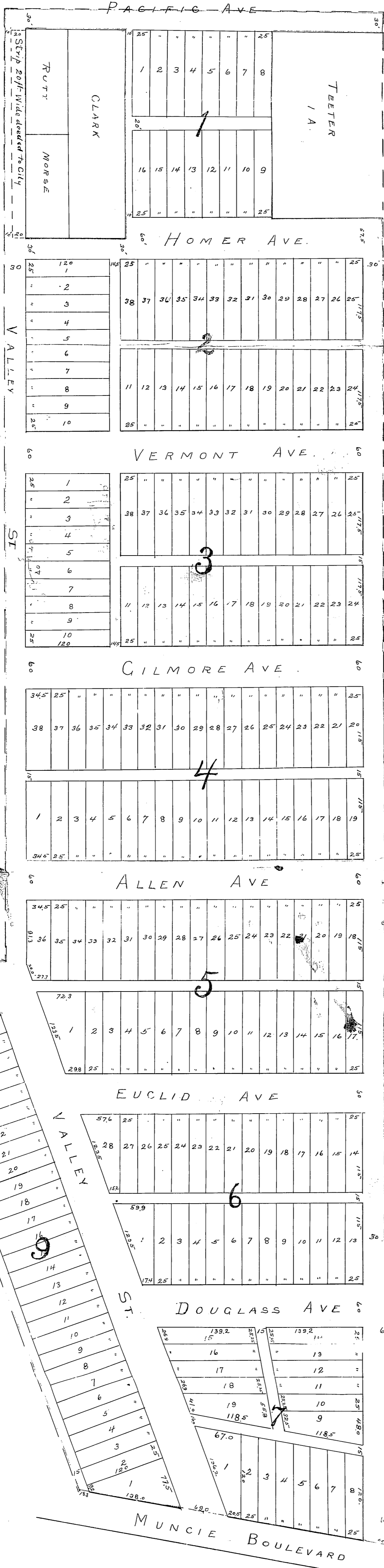


ROCK-ISLAND PLACE

Description.

This plot of ROCK ISLAND PLACE, covers land in Wyandotte County described as follows: Beginning at the Center of Sec. 16, T. 15. R. 25 E. Thence North 1010.4 feet: Thence West 160 feet: Thence North 272.25 feet: Thence East 160 feet: Thence North 30 feet: Thence West 544.5 feet: Thence South 1374.25 feet: Thence West 179.6 feet: Thence S 20° E. 810 feet: Thence S 80° 15' E along the North line of the Muncie Boulevard 635.5 feet: Thence North 471 feet: Thence West 181.5 feet: Thence North 453.5 feet to point of Beginning: Except a tract described as follows: Beginning 30 feet South and 10 feet East of the Northwest Corner of the above described Tract, said point being 30 feet South and 534.5 feet West of the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of the North West Quarter of sec 16-11-25. Thence South 300 feet: Thence East 164.5 feet: Thence North 300 feet: Thence West 164.5 feet to beginning.

The parcels of ground within this plat reserved for public purposes are the Avenues, Streets and Alleys, here shown and the boundaries, Courses and extent thereof are shown and they are respectively donated and dedicated for public use as such Avenues, Streets and Alleys.

The lots intended for sale are designated by small black figures and their precise length and width are shown on the plat. The Blocks are designated by large blue figures.
