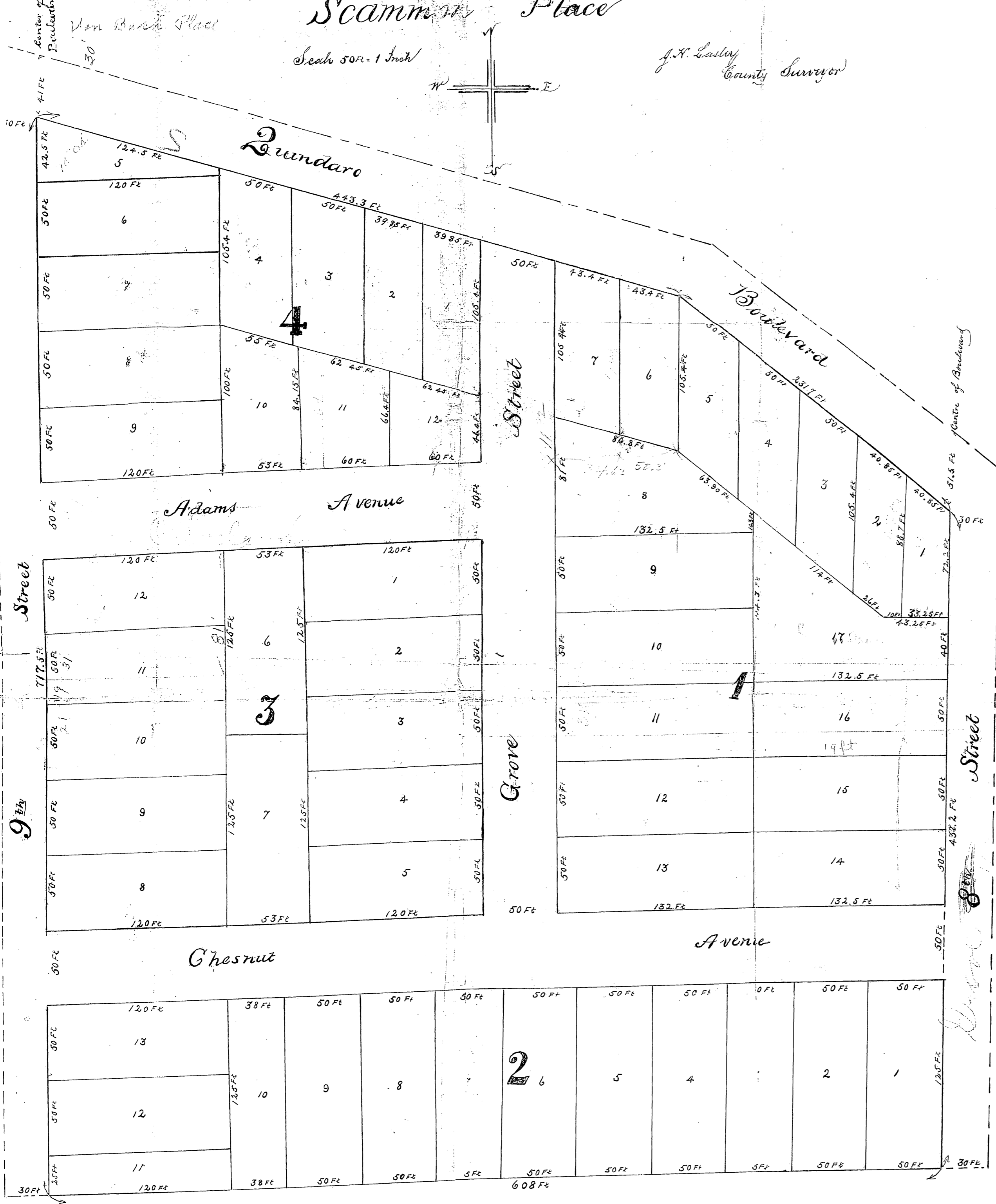


Scammom Place

Scammom Place embraces land in Wyandotte County State of Kansas described as follows:
Commencing at a point two hundred and sixty four (264) feet that and sixteen & one half (16 1/2) feet South of the North-west corner of the South-west quarter of the South-east quarter of Section thirty-three (33) Town ten (10) South Range County from (25) East, thence East six hundred and sixty eight and one quarter (668 1/4) feet, thence North five hundred and eleven and one half (511 1/2) feet to center of Quindaro Boulevard, thence Northwest along center of said Boulevard to a point due north of beginning, thence South to place of beginning.

"Dedication"

The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as Blocks and Lots in Scammom Place. The Blocks being numbered with large blue figures and the Lots with small black figures. The parcels of ground in the subdivision reserved for Public use are Streets and Avenues. The names, extent and direction of all such Streets and Avenues are designated on Plat and are reserved for Public purposes as such. All Lots intended for sale and set forth and described by numbers in Blocks, the precise length and width of each Lot in feet and decimal portions thereof is set forth on this Plat in small black figures.
