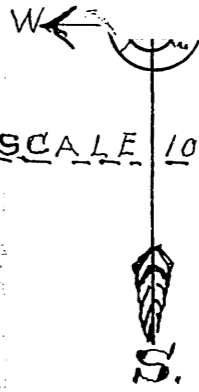


SPRINGFIELD MANOR

SCALE 100' = 1"

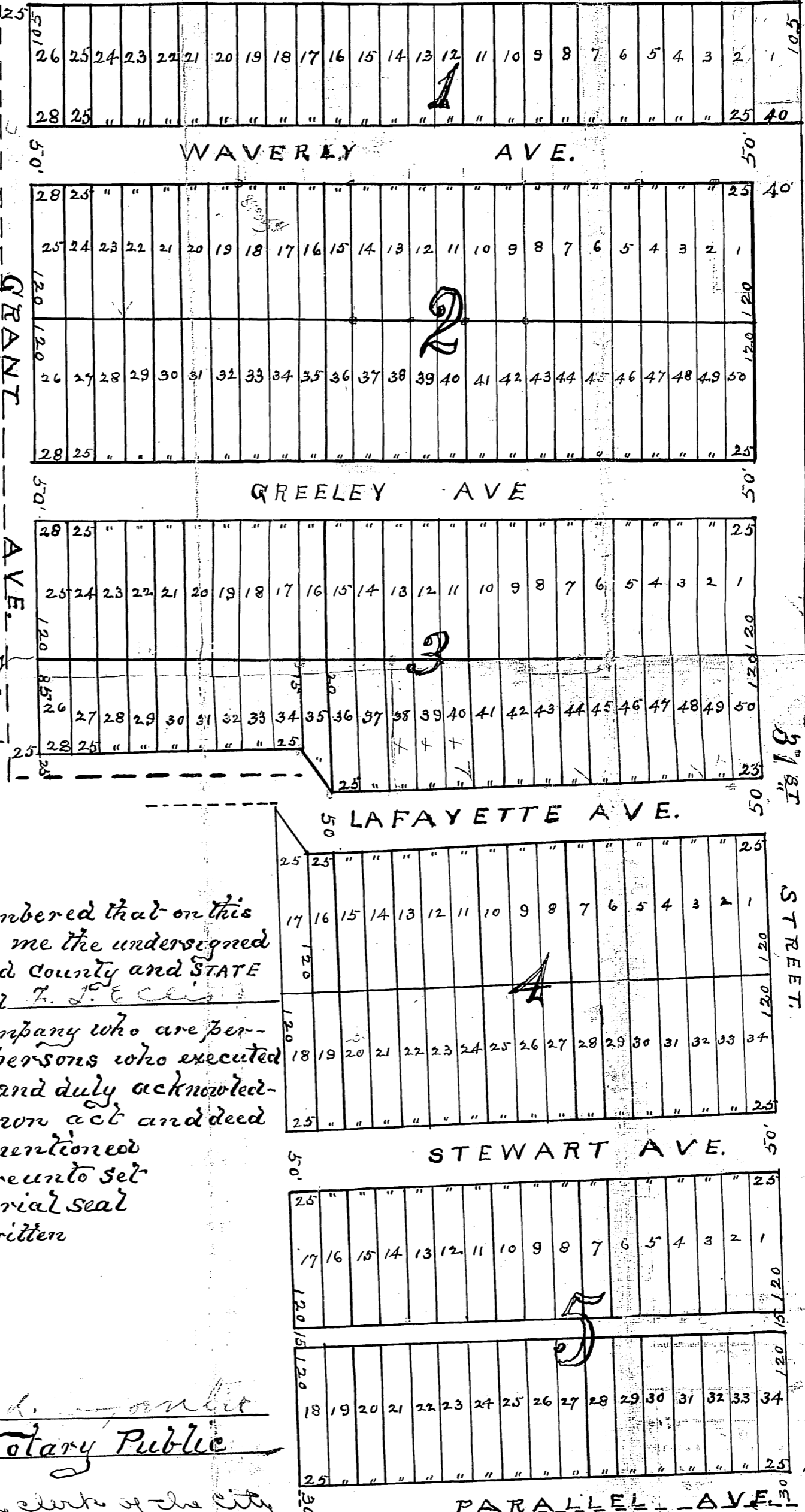
