


PLAT OF THE Subdivision of the Swingley Tract

IN THE NW 1/4 OF SEC. 24-11-24.



Description.

This plat of the Subdivision of the Swingley Tract includes land in Wyandotte County, Kansas, described as follows:

Beginning at the North-west Corner of Section 24 T. 11 S of Range 24 East. Thence South 940.5 feet; thence East 830 feet; thence South 2.06 feet; thence East 1580.37 feet; thence North 942.56 feet; thence West 1860.57 feet to beginning; Excepting the following tracts:

One acre owned by P. Callahan, and designated on this plat as No. 28; the E.R. Barber Tract designated herein as No. 27; tract sold to L.J. Swingley herein designated as No. 26; tract now owned by J.J. Swingley herein designated as No. 24; tract sold to Geo. C. Wilcox herein designated as No. 22; tract owned by D. Wilson, herein designated as No. 29; tract sold to Kingsbury, herein designated as No. 30; tract sold to A. Jasper, and herein designated as No. 31; tract owned by A.L. Strickland, herein designated as No. 34; tract owned by the Joffa Prager Co. herein designated as No. 43. Excepting also a tract heretofore platted as Swingley

Place and a tract platted as Winston Place. Excepting also the right of way of the A.T. & S.F. Ry Co.
