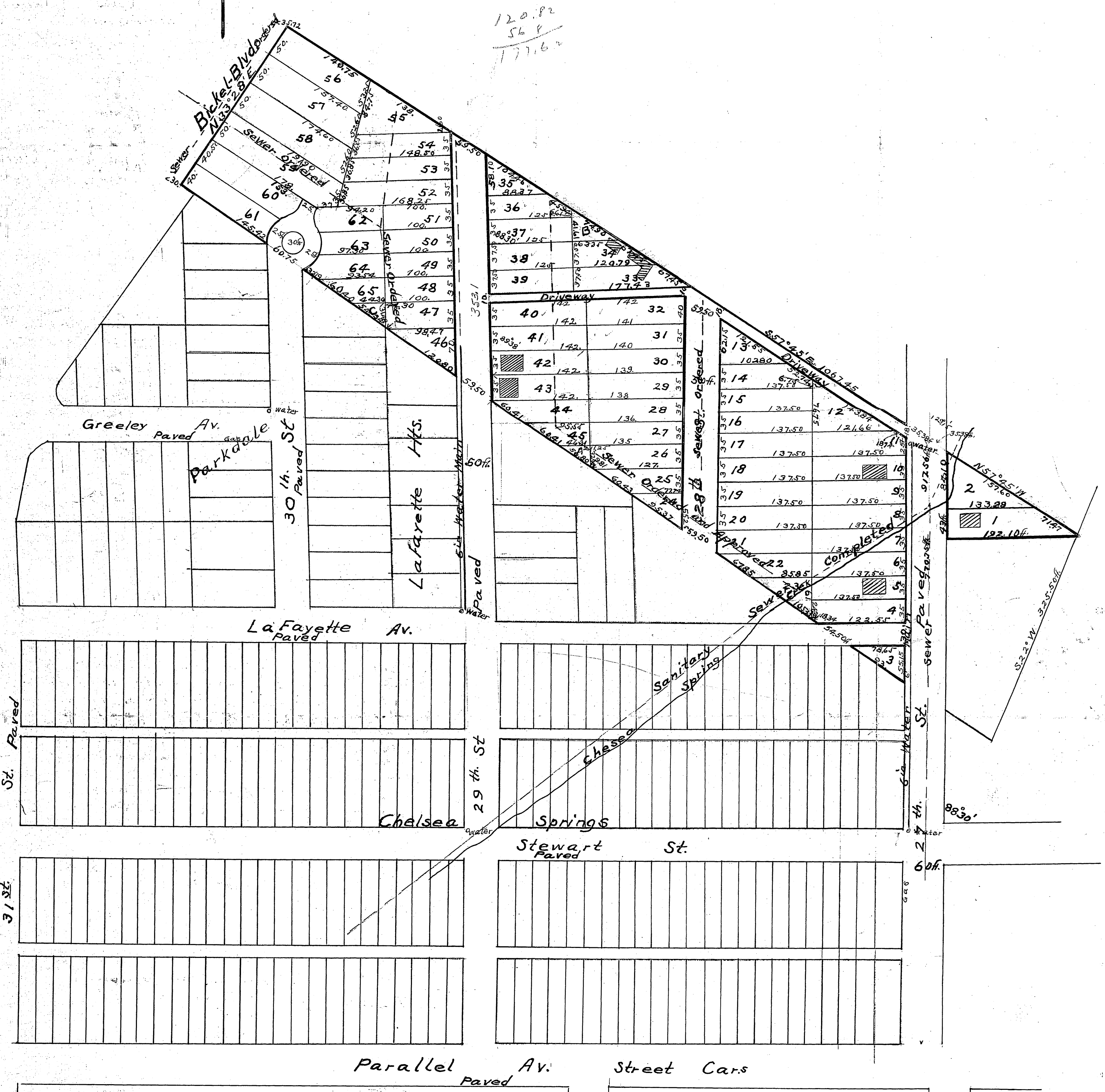


PLAT of THE

Re-Subdivision of Touvant Tracts
This plat of the Re-Subdivision of "Touvant Tracts" embracing the following tract of land as described in the report of the Commissioners appoied in Case Number 7246A of the District Court of Wyandotte County, Kansas Viz.
Beginning at a point 217.8 feet East of the Northwest corner of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South east $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31-10-25 thence North 36° East 280.5 feet thence South $56^{\circ}30'$ East 140.3 feet; thence West 218 feet; thence South 222.5 feet; thence North $55^{\circ}50'$ West 1338 feet to point of beginning, and also described on a plat designated as Tracts Nos 1 to 24 dated July 21st 1922 Recorded in Book of plats No 15 at 26 page
