RESTRICTIONS

THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS SHALL APPLY TO EACH AND EVERY LOT IN TUDOR'S ADDITION:

FIRST: ALL LOTS IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE KNOWN AND DESCRIBED AS RESIDENTIAL LOTS AND NO STRUCTURE SHALL BE ERECTED ON ANY RESIDENTIAL LOT OTHER THAN A ONE DETACHED SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING NOT TO EXCEED 2½ STORIES IN HEIGHT, AND THE USUAL ACCESSORY BUILDINGS INCLUDING A PRIVATE GARAGE.

SECOND: No structure shall be erected on any residential lot nearer than thirty feet to the front Lot line nor nearer than seven feet to any side lot line. The side line restriction shall not apply to a garage located on the rear 25% of a lot, except that on corner lots no structure shall be permitted nearer than twenty feet to the side street line.

THIRD: No residential lot shall be resubdivided into building plots having less than 10,000 square feet of area or a width of less than 70 feet, nor shall any structure be erected on any residential lot having an area of less than 10,000 square feet or a frontage of less than 70 feet.

FOURTH: No trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outbuilding exected in this subdivision shall at any time be used as a residence, temporarily or permanently, nor shall any residence of a temporary character be permitted.

FIFTH: No dwelling costing less than \$5,000.00 shall be permitted on any lot in this subdivision and the ground floor area thereof shall not be less than 7.50 square feet for a one story structure nor less than 750 square feet for a one and one half or two story structure.

SIXTH: No stable, BARN, HOG PEN, OUTSIDE PRIVY, CLOSET OR OPEN CESSPOOL SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED OR MAINTAINED ON THE PROPERTY.

SEVENTH: A PERPETUAL EASEMENT IS RESERVED OVER THE REAR FIVE FEET OR THE SIDE FIVE FEET OF EACH LOT WHERE NECESSARY FOR UTILITY INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE.

EIGHTH: No LOT, IMPROVEMENT OF DWELLING SHALL BE SOLD, RENTED OF LEASED OF THE TITLE IN MANNER PASSED TO ANY PERSONS WHO IS NOT, OR ANY OF WHOSE ANCESTORS, ARE, OR WERE, NOT OF THE CAUCASIAN RACE.

NTH: These covenants and restrictions are to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them until Jan 1st 1978 at which time said covenants and restrictions shall be extended for successive periods of ten years unless by a majority of the then owners of the lots it is agreed to change said covenants in whole or in part.

IENTH: If the parties hereto, or any of them, or their heirs or assigns, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the restrictions herein, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any other lot in said subdivision to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate such restriction, and either to prevent him or them from so doing or to recover damages for such violation Invalidation of any one of the above restrictions shall not invalidate the remaining restrictions.
