

Plat of First Addition to Western Highlands Wyandotte Co. Kas.

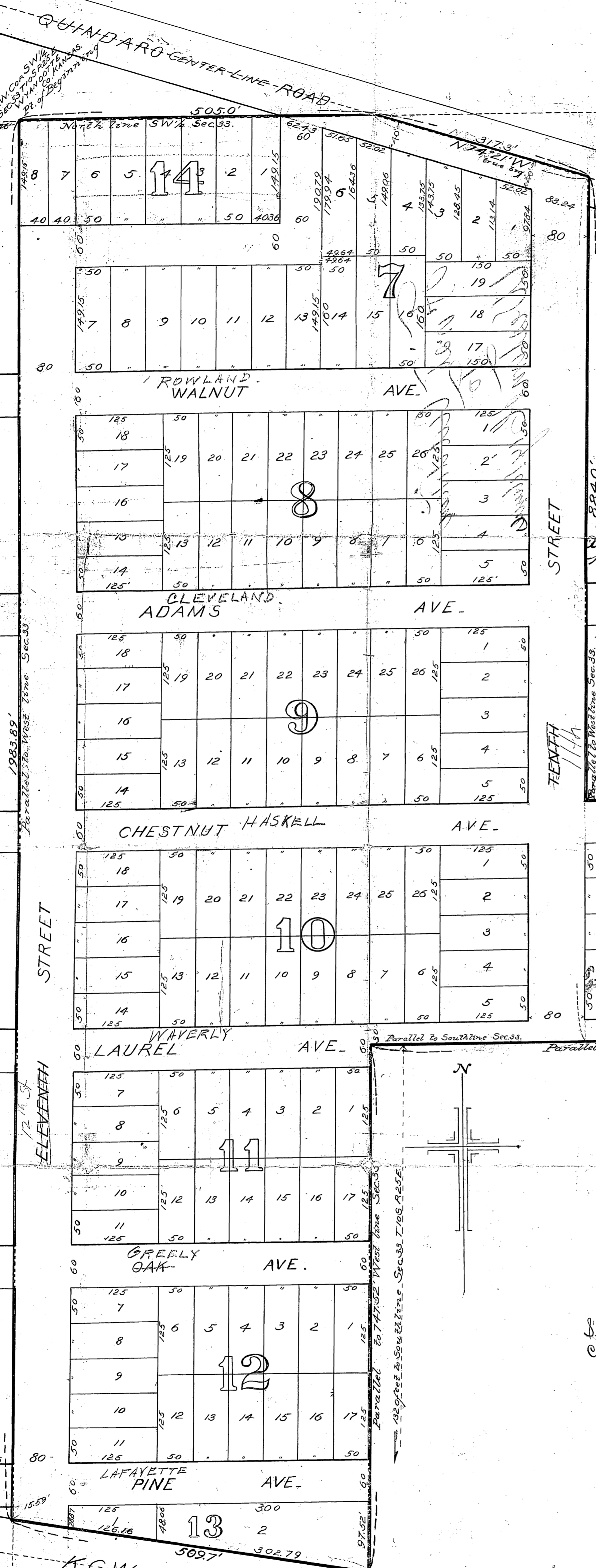
This plat of the First Addition to Western Highlands covers land in the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 33 Twp. 10 S., R. 25 E., Wyandotte Co., Kansas, described as follows: Beginning at a point in the north line of said S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 33, 46 feet east of the west line of said Sec. 33; Thence south parallel to and 46 east of said west line of said Sec. 33, 1983.89 feet to the northerly line of the Right of Way of the K.C.W. & N.W.R.R. Co.; Thence south easterly along said northerly line of right of way, 6897/10 feet; Thence north parallel to the west line of said Sec. 33, 744 5/10 feet; Thence east parallel to and 1320 feet north of the south line of said Sec. 33, 1051 1/10 feet to the west line of Western Highlands; Thence north along said west line 340 feet; Thence west parallel to the south line of said Sec. 33, 748 7/10 feet; Thence north parallel to the west line of said Sec. 33, 884 feet to the center line of "Quindaro Road"; Thence N 74° 21' W. 317 1/10 feet along said center line to the north line of the S.W. 1/4 of said Sec. 33; Thence west along said North line, 505 feet to the point of Beginning.

The lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as lots and blocks in the first addition to Western Highlands. The parcels of ground reserved for public use are avenues and streets. The names, extent and directions of all such avenues and streets are designated on this plat and such avenues and streets are reserved and dedicated for public purpose as such. All lots intended for sale are set forth and described by numbers in blocks. The precise length and width of each lot is marked thereon in feet and decimal parts thereof. The number of each lot is shown in small red figures and the number of each block in large blue figures.
