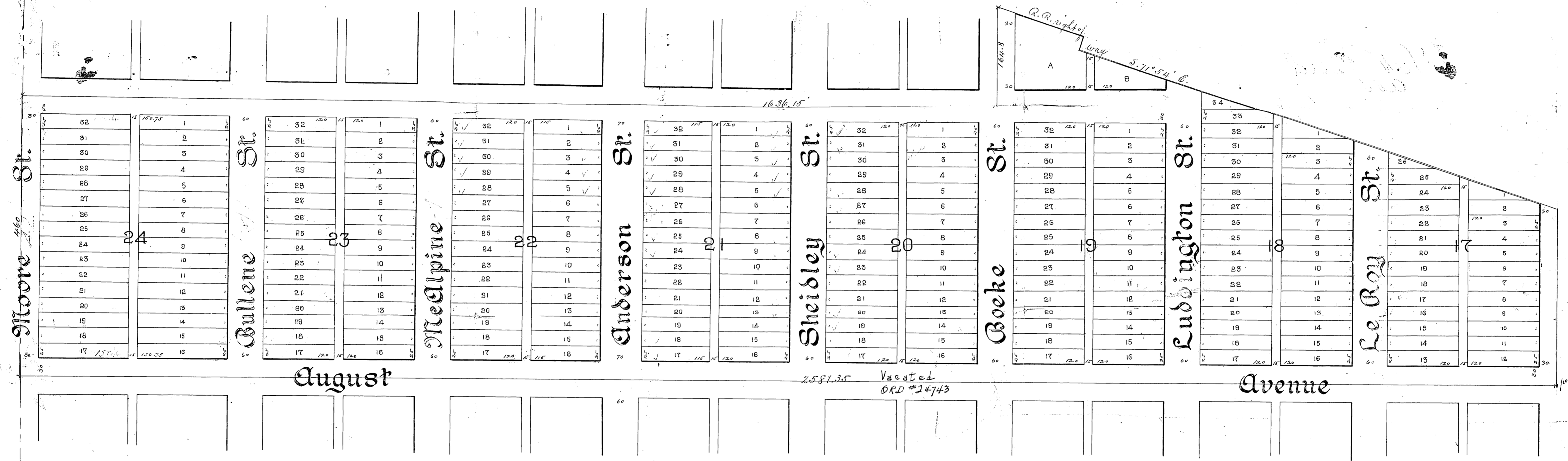


West End ADDITION TO ARGENTINE

"Description"

"West End Addition to Argentine" is situated in Wyandotte County Kansas, and described as follows to-wit:
Commencing at a point 76 1/2 feet west and 95.5 feet North from the intersection of the center Line of Strong Avenue in Adams and Kings Addition to Argentine with the East Line of Section 14, S. 11, R. 25 East, Thence West 2581. 1/2 feet Thence North 460 feet, Thence East 1636. 1/2 feet, Thence North 164.8 feet to the south line of The Kansas City Traction and Western Ry. Company's right of way, Thence North 71° 54' E. along said right of way to a point due North of Commencing, thence South to the Place of Beginning.

"Dedication"

The Lands reserved for sale are described by numbers as Blocks and Lots in West End Addition to Argentine, The Blocks being numbered with large and the Lots with small black figures; The parcels of ground in the subdivision reserved for Public use are, Streets, avenues, and alleys, The names, extent and direction of all which Streets, Avenues and Alleys are designated on this plat and are reserved and dedicated for Public purposes as such. All Lots intended for sale are set forth and described by number in Blocks; The precise length and width of each lot in feet and decimal portions thereof is set forth on this Plat in small black figures.
