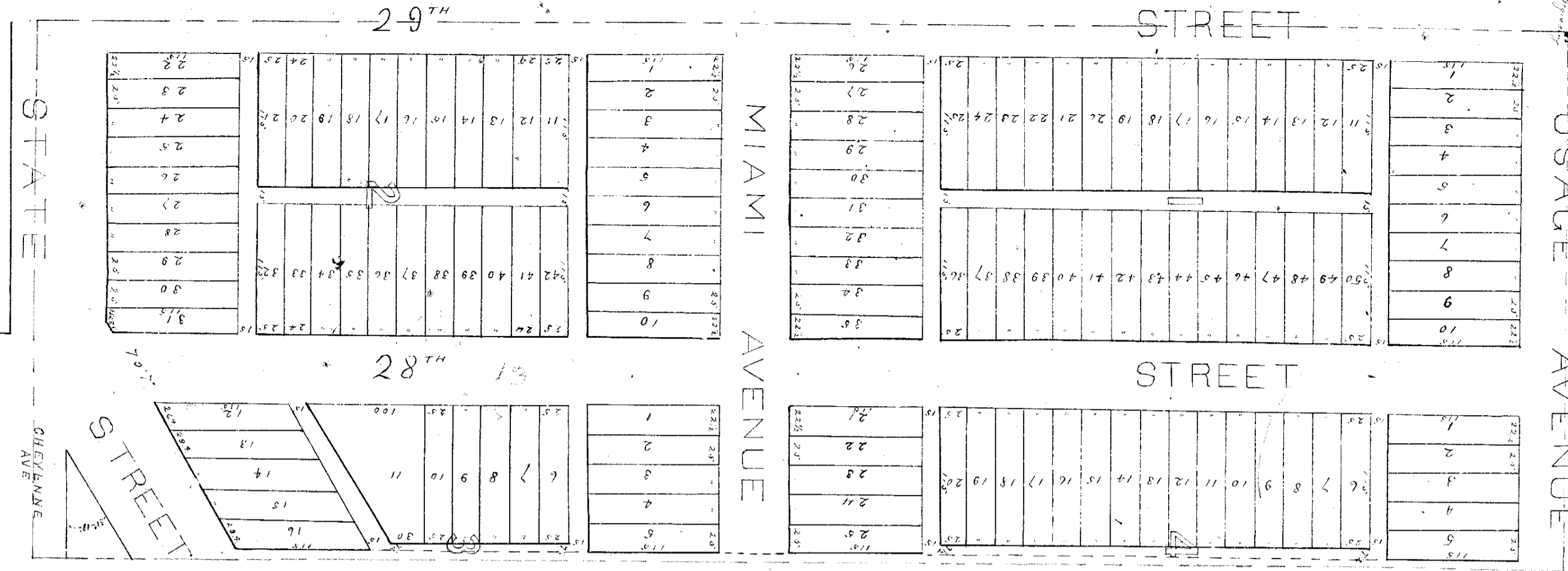


MAP OF WILLIAMSON PLACE WYANDOTTE COUNTY KANSAS

LASLEY & BORKER CIVIL ENGINEERS SALES 1/4 INCH = 50 FEET

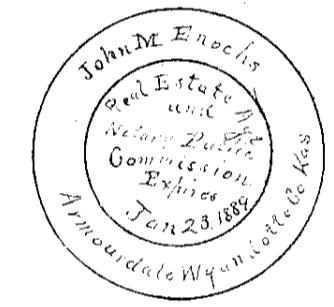

Westerly along the same 142 1/2 ft; thence West to a point due South of by; thence North to beginning and containing 141 Acres more or less. Dedication: Know all Men by these presents that we, J. P. Williamson & Rebecca A Williamson his wife, and Allan Chadwick & Emaline Chadwick his wife owners of the above described land, do hereby dedicate and convey to the public for their use the Streets, Avenues & Alleys named and designated within the foregoing description according to the accompanying plat and it is hereby expressly understood that no right or privilege whatever is hereby granted or dedicated excepting the simple easement of travel over said Streets, Avenues & Alleys.

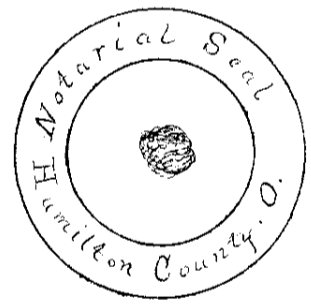

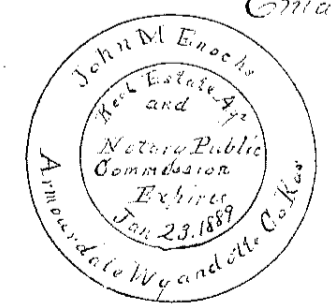


Know all men by these presents that in order to more certainly comply with requirements of the Statutes of the State of Kansas governing the recording of Town Plats we hereby make the following Supplemental description of the accompanying Plat to wit: All lots in this plat are One hundred and fifty feet deep and they are all Twenty five (25) feet wide except lots numbered One (1) & Two (2) in Block numbered One (1) and lots numbered One (1) Ten (10) Twenty two (22) and Thirty one (31) in Block numbered Two (2) and lots numbered One (1) and Twelve (12) in Block numbered Three (3) and lots numbered One (1) and Twenty one (21) in Block numbered Four (4) each of which is Twenty two and one half (22 1/2) feet wide. And the lots in Block numbered Two (2) from Twelve (12) to Twenty (20) inclusive and from Thirty three (33) to Forty one (41) inclusive each of are Twenty four feet (24) wide. And lot numbered Eleven (11) in Block numbered Three (3) which is One hundred (100) feet wide in front and thirty feet wide in the rear. Miami Street and Twenty eighth Street are each Sixty (60) feet wide. One half of Twenty ninth Street is Thirty (30) feet wide and one half of State Street and Osage Avenue are each Forty (40) feet wide. The Alleys are all Fifteen (15) feet wide.

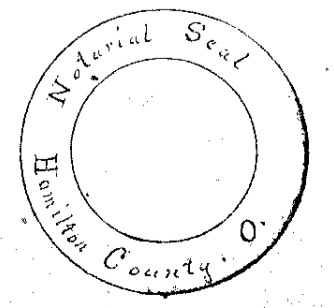
