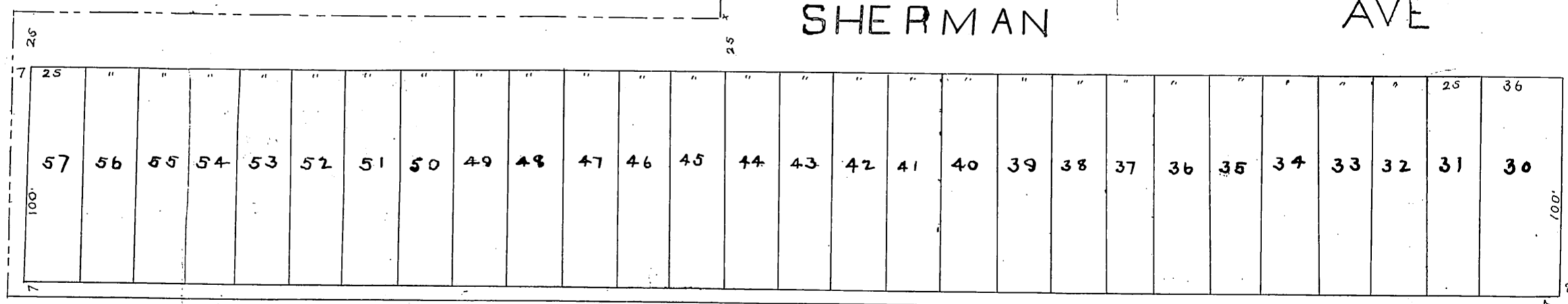
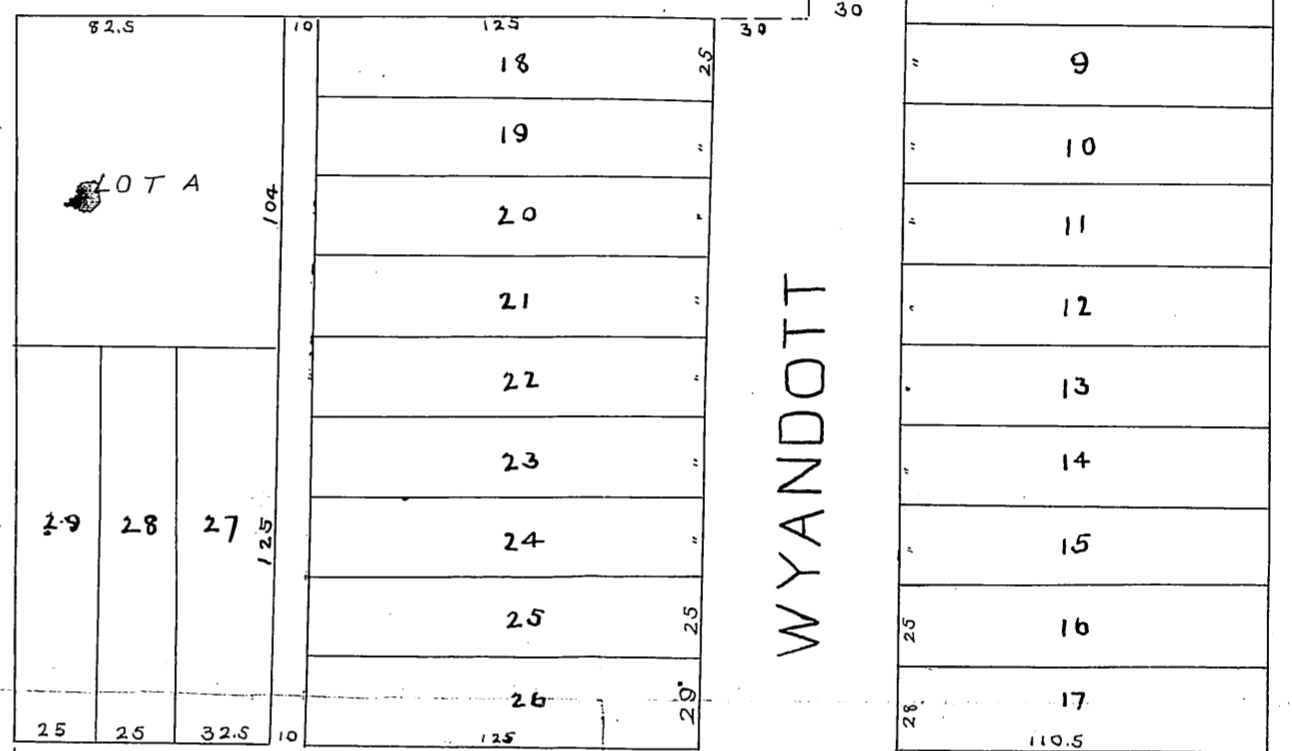

Winter Park is embraced within the boundaries beginning at the southwest corner of the North West quarter of the South West quarter of section ten (10) Township Eleven (11) Range Twenty-five (25) East North eight (8) poles East twenty (20) poles, North sixteen (16) poles, East fifteen (15) poles, North sixteen (16) poles, East nine (9) poles, South forty (40) poles, West forty four (44) poles to beginning, five and one half (5 1/2) Acres.

The lands here described are divided into lots streets and alleys. Streets are named and the dimensions of lots and widths of streets and alleys are given on the plat in feet and tenths of feet. The streets and alleys are hereby dedicated to the Public as thoroughfares.
