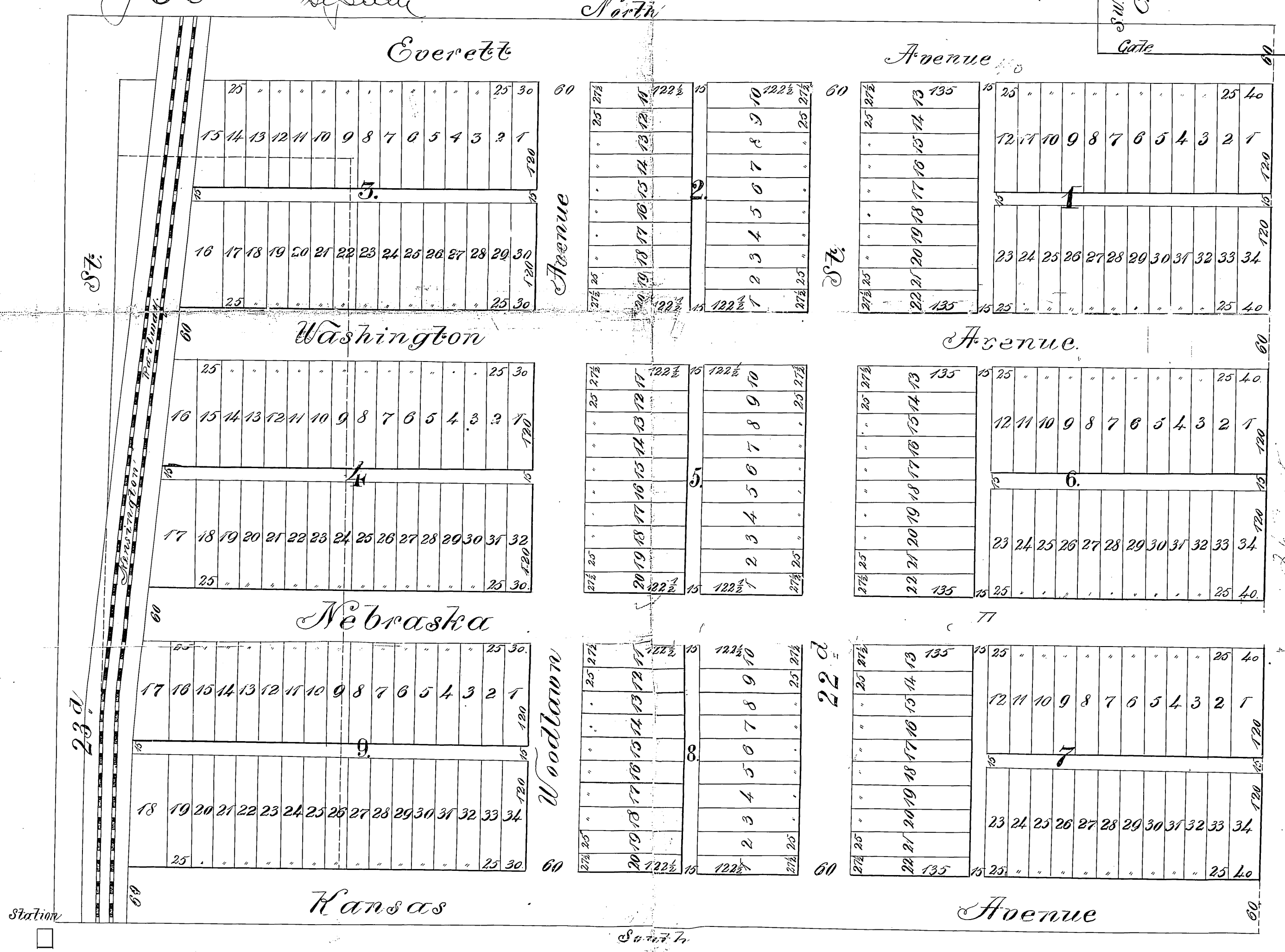

Description: Commencing at a point 264 feet East of the S.W. corner, of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5 Town M Range 25, thence East 1056 feet, thence North 937 feet, thence West 1320 feet, thence South 142 feet, thence East 264 feet, thence South 825 feet to place of Beginning situated in Wyandotte County, State of Kansas.

Also: Beginning at the S.W. corner, of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5 Town M Range 25, thence North 825 feet, thence East 264 feet, thence South 825 feet to the County Road, thence West 264 feet, to place of Beginning situated in Wyandotte County, State of Kansas.

We the proprietors of the above described tracts of real estate situated in Wyandotte County, Kansas, have caused the same to be subdivided in the manner shown on this plat into an addition to Kansas City, Kansas, which addition shall hereafter be known as Woodlawn Addition to Kensington. All Streets and Alleys as designated in this plat are hereby donated to public use forever.
